

# Prayer Word: Inclusion (Week 1) by Pastor Carl



Have you ever felt like you were not really included in something? Perhaps it was being picked last for a team. Maybe it was not getting the message about a dress code for an event and feeling out of place because you dressed significantly differently from everyone else (like wearing a UofA jersey to an ASU game). Imagine visiting a church for the first time and no one speaks with you; not a hello, nothing. You look around and don't see anyone in your age group. They sing songs that are unfamiliar to you but are clearly familiar to everyone else there. It would be hard to feel included in the community of faith in such a situation, or at least a part of that congregation. Inclusion begins by recognizing differences and welcoming the differences into the larger body. God created each of us slightly differently from each other, despite the consistency of our DNA. How many of us recognize Cinco de Mayo with (Americanized) Mexican food? Or celebrate St. Patrick's Day by wearing green and consuming greencolored foods and beverages? We are enriched by the different flavors and sounds of those and other cultures. Inclusion is when we participate in and celebrate the differences that bring us together.


