

Prayer Word: Faith (Week 2) by Pastor Carl

Faith is not blind or futile hope. Hebrews 11:1a reminds us that faith is the assurance of things hoped for, but that is not completely helpful. We have faith in the one who will provide that which is hoped for and that what we hope for is the right thing. Many people lose their faith in God when a loved one dies. They sometimes say, "I don't know why my loved one died. She/he was such a strong believer." Sometimes, out of anger, the grieving family member may say something like, "I can't believe in God anymore. I prayed and prayed, but my loved one died anyway." In both of these statements, we can hear that God did not grant a wish for someone, but we have to profess that God is not a wish-granter. We fail to recognize that death is a part of this life and our hope is for the transformation of the world that the sovereignty of God is proclaimed in this world as it is in Heaven. Our hope should be for eternal life with God, in service to God. Whatever our hopes, though, we must exert effort. If we hope to lose weight, eating right and exercise are the standard approaches (though surgery, drugs, and other approaches are possibilities too). If we hope to end world hunger but are not contributing to support humanitarian aid to places afflicted by hunger, including our metropolitan areas, we don't really have hope – it's a wish. If we have hope in Christ but are not engaged in Christ's ministries through our tithes, our offerings, and our actions, it's a wish. If we have faith in Christ, we will show that by being changed to be Christ-like ourselves.






