Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group. (15 Min)

- What are some of the craziest fake news stories that you have read?
- What would you consider a reliable source when it comes to information? Why do you trust it?

Head: Start Thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking. (10 Min)

- Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What does it say about scripture?
- Read Matthew 5:18, John 10:35, and John 17:17. Does Jesus have a low view of scripture or a high view?
- In 2 Timothy 3:16, it says that "All Scripture is breathed out by God."
 Re-read this section in the NIV and GW translations and discuss –
 what does it mean?

Heart: Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness. (10 Min)

- Have you ever heard the question, "Why should I believe in the authority of the bible?" What are some reasons that people would raise to call into question its authenticity?
- What evidence have you heard that shows the reliability of the Bible?
- For you what does it come down to when deciding what we are reading is true? How do you personally know that it can be trusted?

Hands: Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week. (10 Min)

- Do your current Bible habits match your how valuable God's Word is?
