Reboot End of the Matter



Key Scripture

9 Besides being wise, the Preacher also taught the people knowledge, weighing and studying and arranging many proverbs with great care. 10 The Preacher sought to find words of delight, and uprightly he wrote words of truth. 11 The words of the wise are like goads, and like nails firmly fixed are the collected sayings; they are given by one Shepherd. 12 My son, beware of anything beyond these. Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh. 13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group. (15 Min)

Heart: Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness. (10 Min)

- What is your personal take away from this study? Has anything stood out to you?
- Why is living for just ourselves pointless in the end? How can putting God first add more meaning to our lives?
- How can your lifestyle be more God-centered?
- How can your life fulfill the vision of "loving your neighbor?"

Hands: Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week. (10 Min)

- Check out some of the "I am second" videos on YouTube this week. Share one that you like with a friend.
- Finish this sentence "I can put God first this week by..."

Start Praying. Be bold and pray with power. (15 Min)
