Latin for: "Spiritural Reading"

4 Steps/Movements:
READ
REFLECT
RESPONSE

READ: Slowly, Prayerfully, & Intentionally Pay attention to words/phrases that resonate or speak to you



REFLECT: Read again slowly, pause over the words/phrases that resonate. Allow them to fill your heart and mind as you consider them.

RESPONSE: Pray your impressions back to God. Tell Him how is the scripture striking you. Tell Him what it brings to mind.



REST: Rest in silence. Slow your mind & breath. Rest in God's love and Word.
