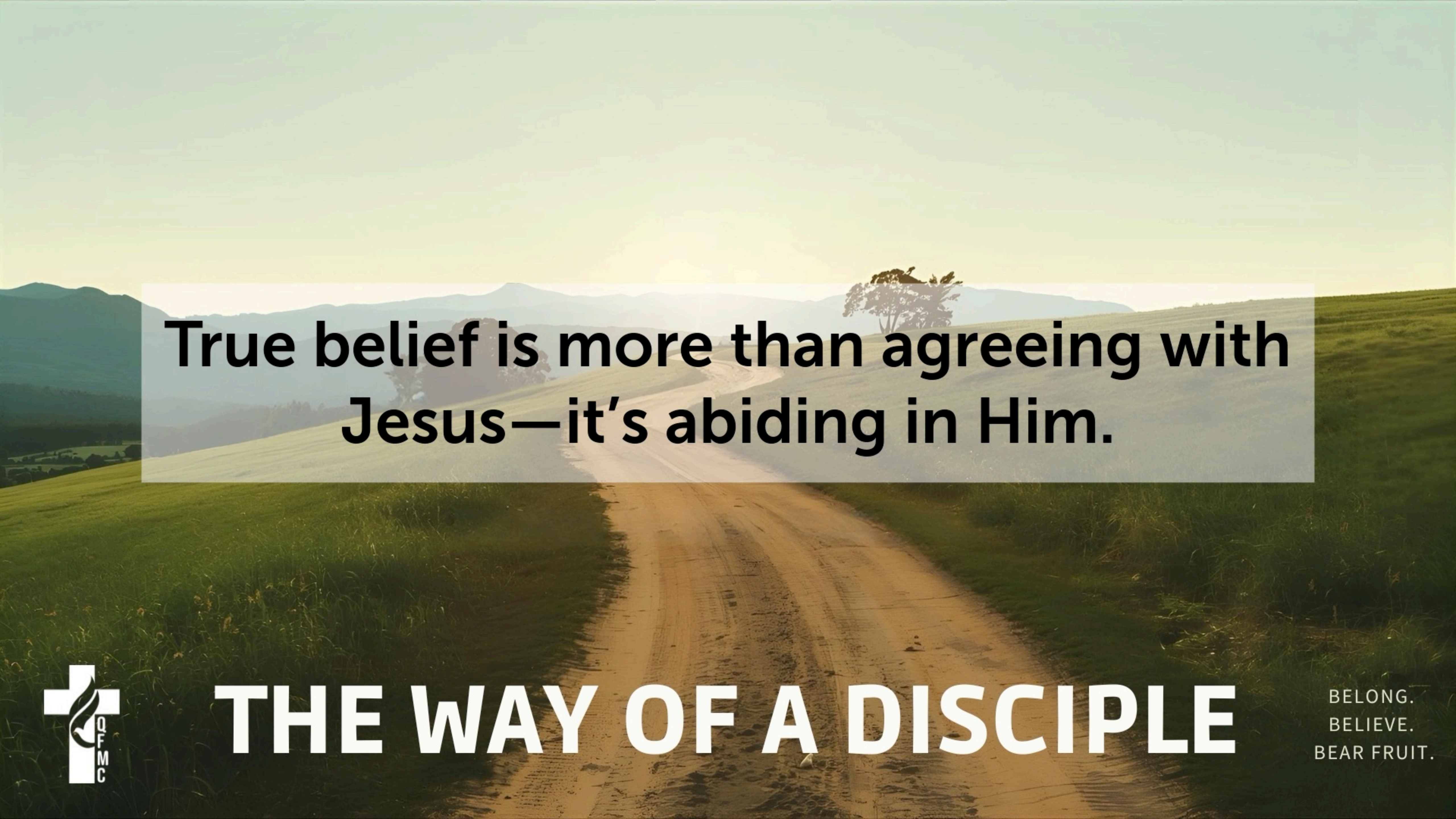

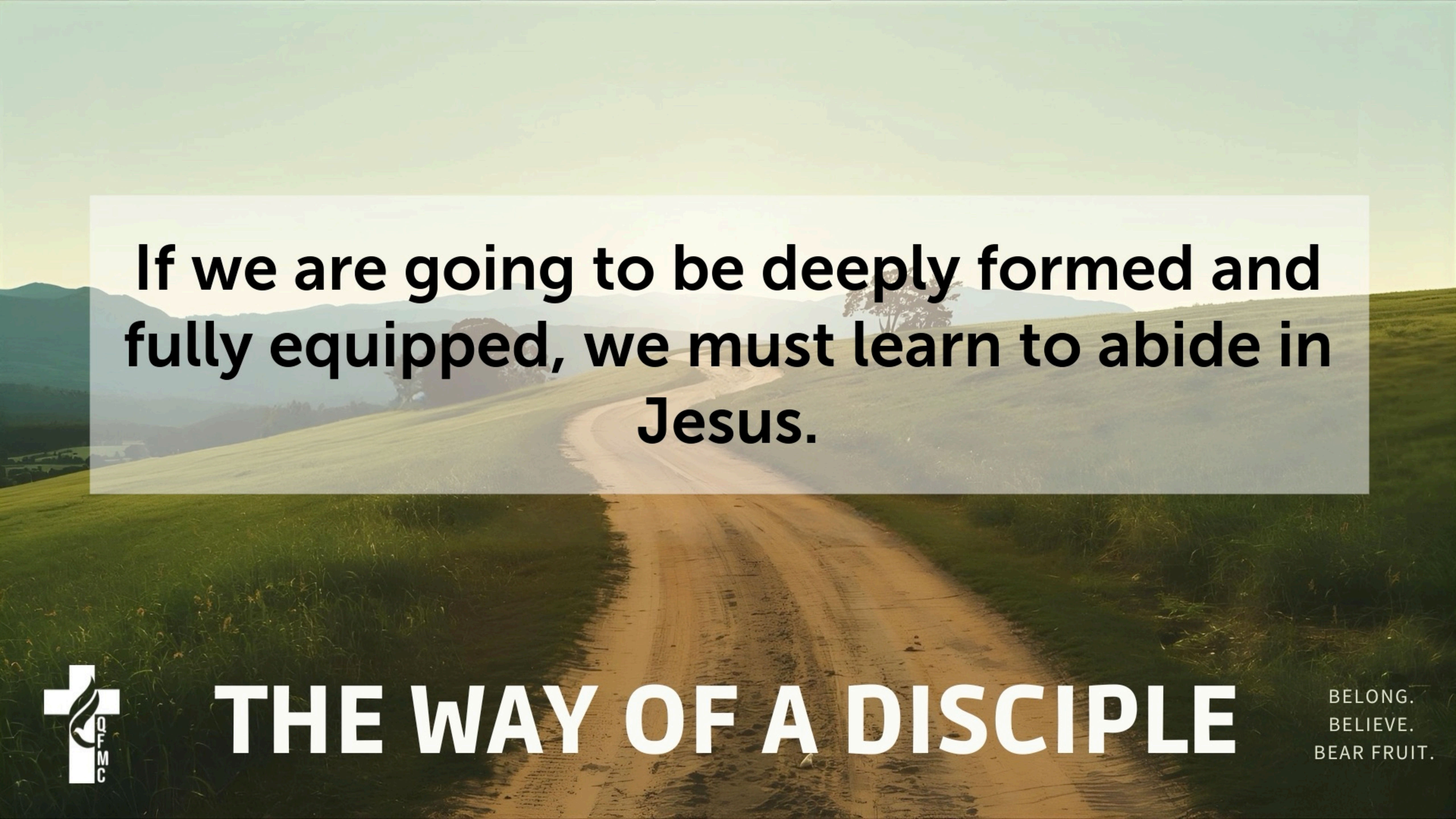

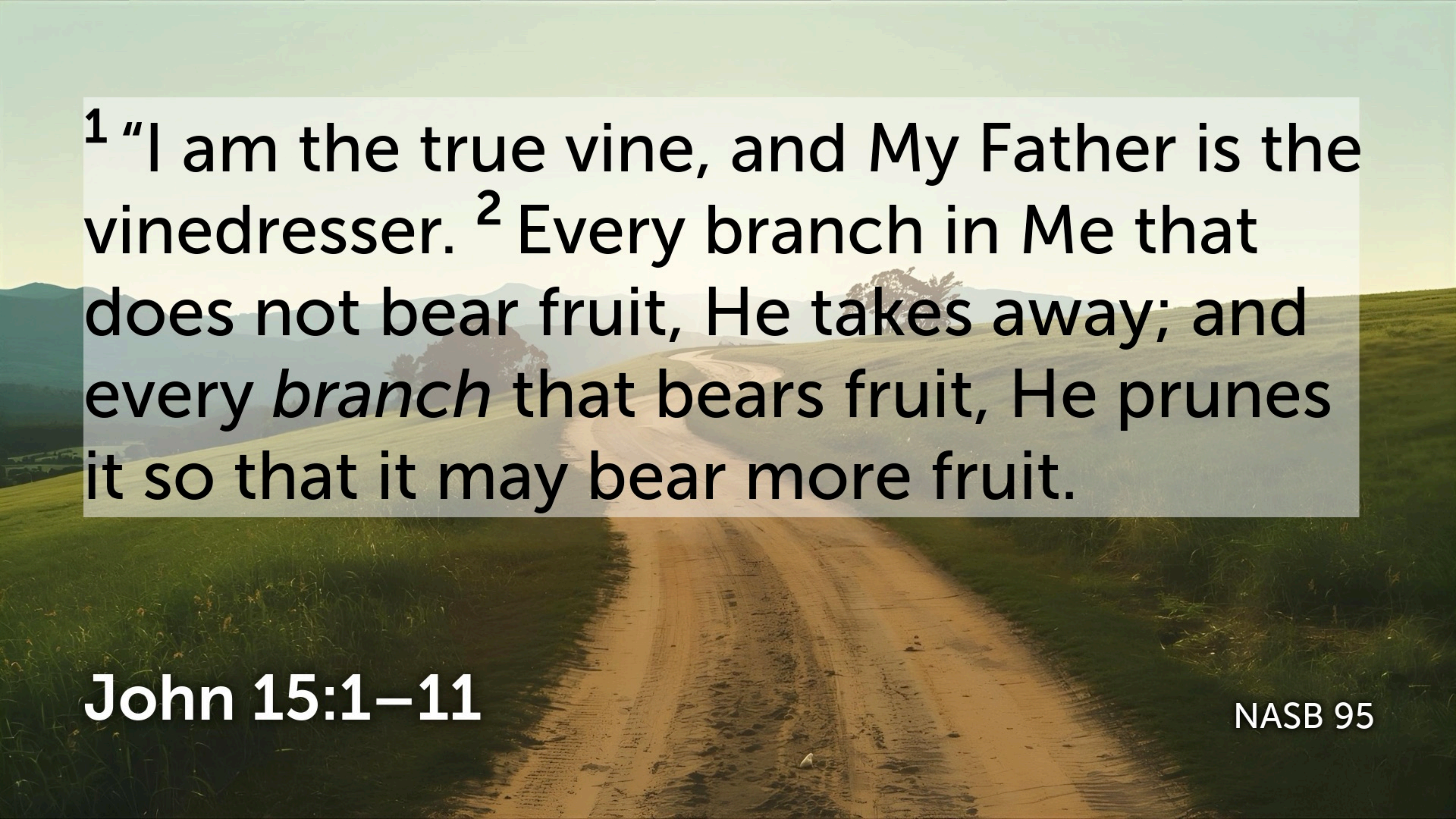


If we are going to be deeply formed and fully equipped, we must learn to abide in Jesus.

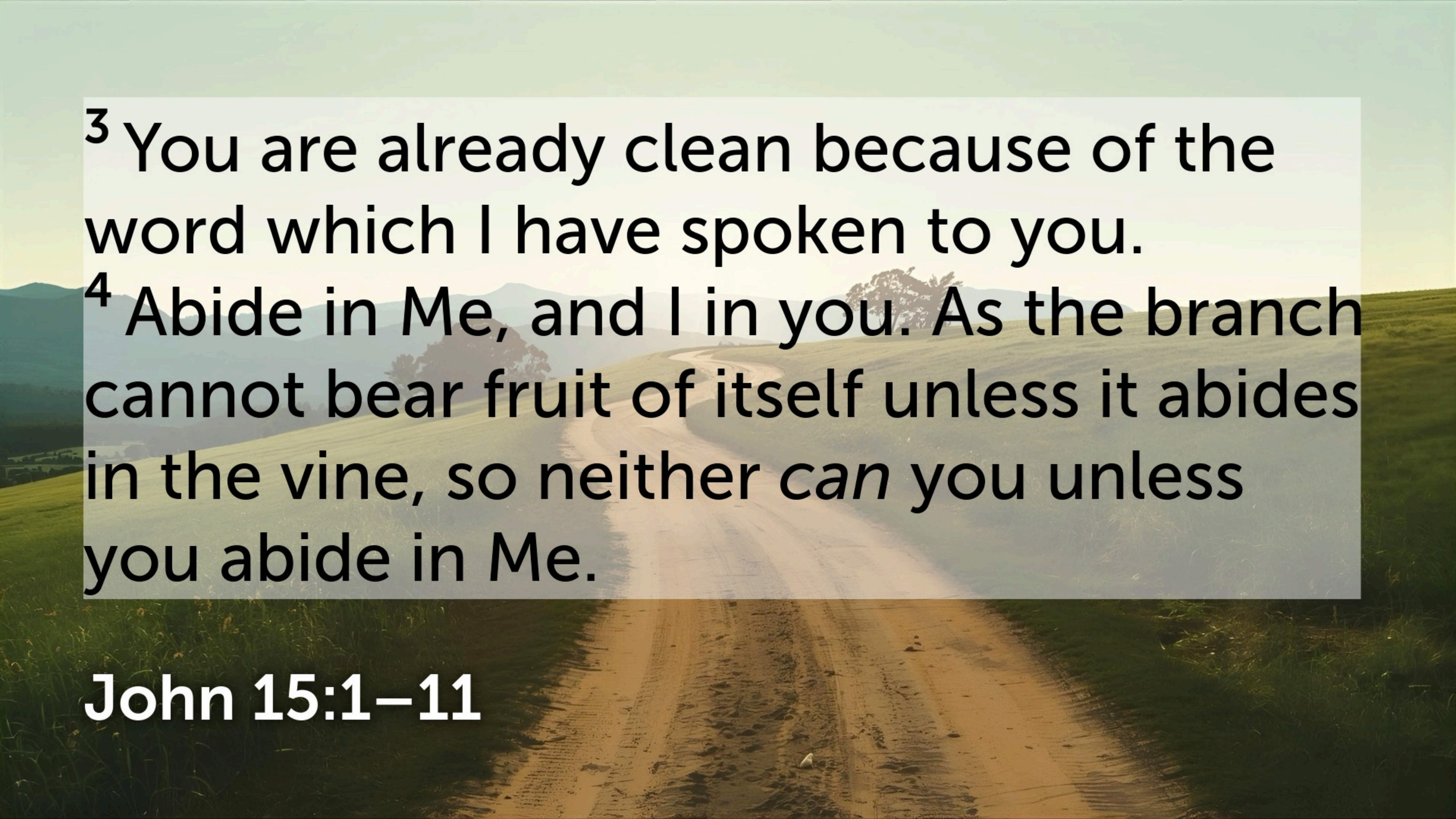

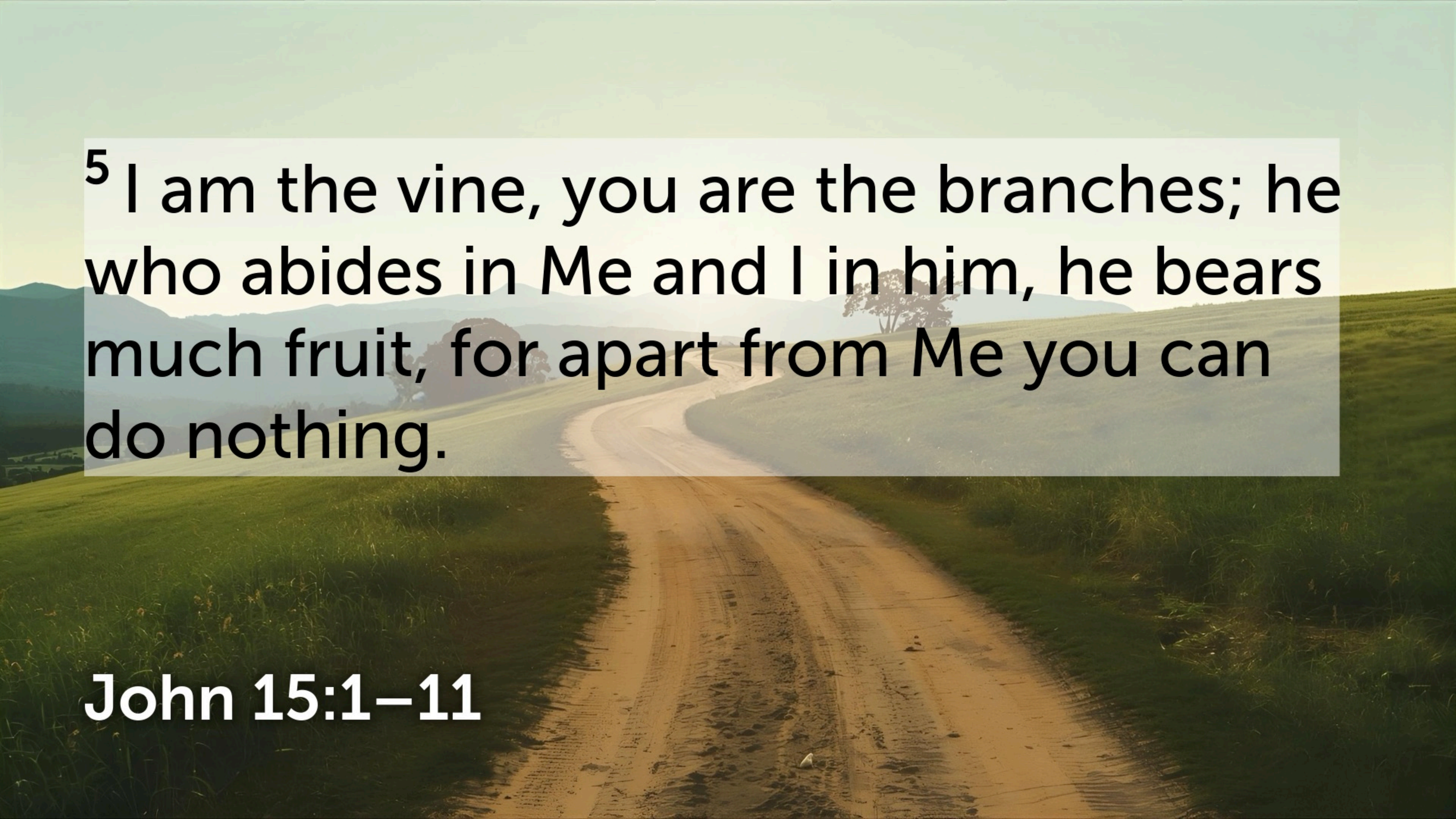

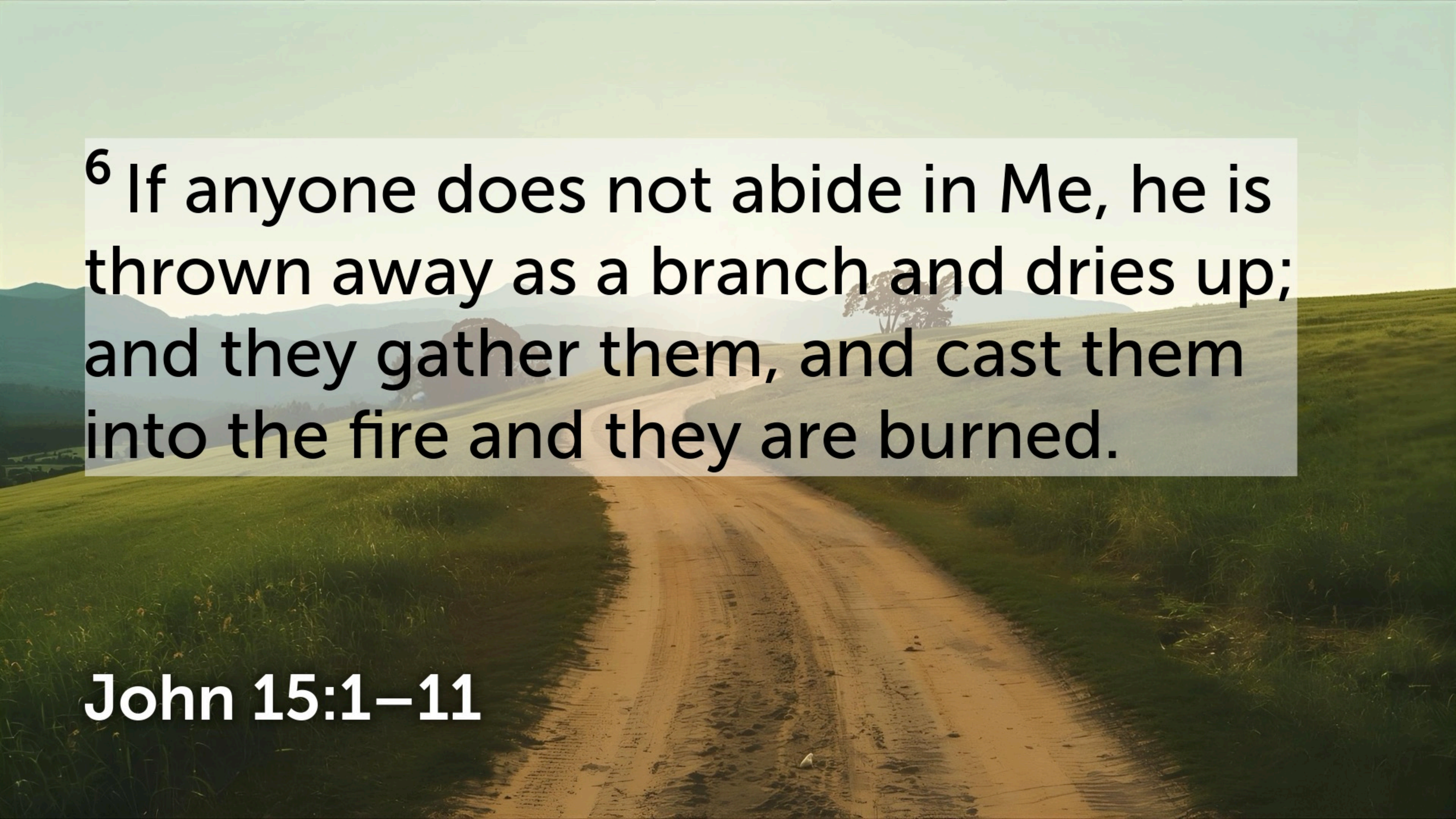
⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can* you unless you abide in Me.
