Recall from last week the two greatest commandments (Matthew 22:37-40). Is it easier to live up to these while single or in a relationship? How so?

Read 1 Corinthians 7:32-35. A single person can be far more devoted to God than one with other distractions. How have you seen this to be true in your own life or the lives of others?

It is not wrong to long for a relationship. It is wrong to let that longing lead your life. Do you define your life by your relationship status? How so? If you are single, how are you using this season to further your relationship with God and helping to build His kingdom? If you are in a relationship, how did you use your prior season of singleness to further your relationship with God and helping to build His kingdom? How do you see that continuing to play out in the future?
