Eido: “to know”

(knowing something
from a factual standpoint)

EIDO VS GINOSKO

Ginosko: “to know”

(Implies a deep, intimate and experiential knowledge rather than just factual information. It can encompass understanding, feeling, and coming to know something or someone through personal experience)
