3. Teach your children to obey you and follow your guidance through PROPER Biblical discipline.

TEACHING TO:

4. Protect your children from ungodly influences by being aware of Satan's methods and attempts to destroy them through worldly attractions.

(Pr. 13:20; 28:7; 1 Co 15:33; 1Jn 2:15-17)

TEACHING TO:

5. Teach your children to know that God is always observing what they think and say.
(Psalm 139:1-12)

TEACHING TO:

6. Teach your children to accept Christ and entrust themselves to Him as the Forgiver of their sins and Leader of their life.

7. Teach your children to separate themselves from the ungodly beliefs and behaviors that are common in the world and to encourage them to talk about their faith and calling.

8. Teach your children how to be established in a spiritually solid, Bible-based church where God's Word is taught without compromise, His standards honored, and the Holy Spirit operated freely.

9. Teach your children to understand the importance of and the need for a close relationship with the Holy Spirit.

10. Teach your children that God loves them and has a calling on their life. Help them find and develop their unique gifts, talents and abilities and lead them into opportunities to use them.

11. Teach your children to honor God
through their finances.
