1. Connection and belonging are crucial for mental and emotional help

2. Combats Ioneliness

3. Provides a sense of identity through connection to something larger than oneself

- 4. Safety net during crises. This provides emotional support, practical help, and a reminder that they're not alone
- 5. Shared moments within a community bring joy through a shared purpose
- 6. Engaging with others allows for new perspectives and creates an environment for personal growth, where individuals can both give and receive.

7. Helps individuals and the group as a whole be more resilient during hardships.
