TEMPLE BUIDLING

Building the House of God wasn't just about constructing a building, it was meant to restore true worship in Jerusalem, to be obedient to God and complete the project to please the Lord, and to be a great testimony to the unbelieving nations who were watching.

TEMPLE BUIDLING

Haggai delivers three more brief messages to encourage the Jewish people to not give up on the project at hand. In each of these messages, he asks them to look in a specific direction to learn what God wanted them to learn.

Haggai 2:1-9

Encouragement 1: God's Presence Haggai 2:4-9

"Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said 'Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you'. Remember your leaders, who spoke the Word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever."

-Hebrews 13:5; 7-8

"Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. Encouragement 2: God's Covenant Haggai 2:5

LOOKING WITHIN: "SELF-REFLECTION OF CONTAMINATION"

Question #1: Holiness (Haggai 2:11-12)

When an animal was presented at the alter as a sacrifice, the meat was considered holy. Even though the garment is holy/set apart because of the sanctified meat, this holiness can't be imparted to other objects.

LOOKING WITHIN: "SELF-REFLECTION OF CONTAMINATION"

Question #2: Defilement (Haggai 2:13)

You transmit defilement from one thing or person to another, but not sanctity.

LOOKING WITHIN: "SELF-REFLECTION OF CONTAMINATION"

The people working on the temple could not impart any holiness to it, but they could defile it with their sins. It wasn't just important to do God's work, but also that they do His work with pure and clean hearts.

LOOKING AHEAD: "GOD'S PLAN IN FROM AN ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE"

"But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light."

-1 Peter 2:9

1. God's work has begun, is sustained, and built of the foundation of His Word and Christ.

2. My PERSONAL relationship with God is not to fix me up to look attractive to the world, but to grow me as I along with the Church/Bride of Christ get built into the House of God. God's servants must work together to build the House of the Lord.

3. Fix your eyes not on what is seen, but what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

 Putting God first is the guarantee for His blessing in Kingdom work.

5. Apart from the power of the Holy Spirit, our labor is in vain.

-Why are you in Cordova, Alaska? What is your purpose? Is it to be light & salt and to bring people to the knowledge of a need for a Lord and Savior?

SPEND TIME:
