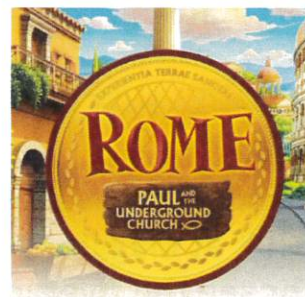
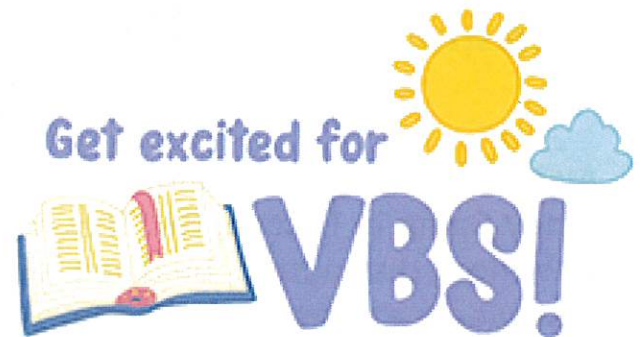

**“Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my rock and my Redeemer.” - Psalm 19: 14**

There is something deeply convicting about David’s prayer in Psalm 19: 14. David is not only concerned with what comes out of his mouth, but also with what takes place within his heart. He understands that both our words and our inward thoughts matter before God. The “meditations” of the heart are the things we dwell upon, the thoughts we nurture, the desires we entertain, and the affections we cultivate. David’s longing is that every part of him - both public and private- would be pleasing in the sight of God.

But this kind of life does not happen accidentally. It comes through intentional mindfulness and a heart fixed upon the Lord. Earlier in the Psalm, David declares, “The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display His craftsmanship.” As I read those words, I find myself both convicted and sobered. How often do I fail to truly notice the splendor of God displayed all around me? How often am I too distracted to marvel at His creation? Flowing from a heart of worship is the desire that the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart would be pleasing to so beautiful a God, so magnificent a Creator. Oh, to be truly enamored with Yahweh.

Yet I find myself guilty as a distracted man. So much of our attention has been stolen by endless scrolling, notifications, reels, entertainment, busy schedules, and countless man-made distractions. Our worship suffers when our eyes are constantly fixed downward instead of upward. We become so consumed with temporary things that we stop noticing the majesty of the eternal God.

My challenge to you is simple: stop and observe the beauty and majesty of God. When was the last time you looked up into the night sky and gazed at the stars? Those distant lights scattered across the heavens were placed there by the hand of God Himself. Many of you will visit the beach this summer- when you stand upon the shoreline, pause and look across the vastness of the waters. Feel the breeze upon your face. Listen to the crashing waves. Let your heart be stirred to worship. Let the utterance of your mouth simply be, “Thank You, my God.”

Creation is constantly declaring His glory. The question is whether we are slowing down enough to hear it. And perhaps as our hearts become captivated again by the beauty of God, we will find ourselves praying alongside David: “Lord, let my words, my thoughts, and my heart be pleasing to You.”

### Collecting Used Grocery Bags

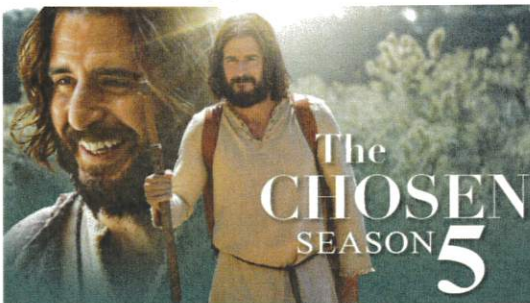

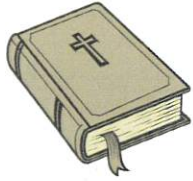

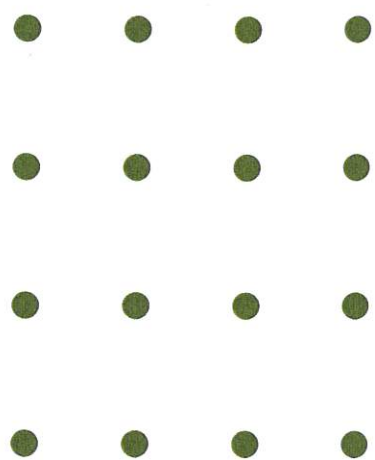

### Cornbread Salad

1 large pan of cornbread. crumbled  
2 cans whole kernel corn drained  
1 green pepper, diced  
1 red pepper, diced  
1 sweet onion, diced  
1 or 2 tomatoes, diced  
1 large bottle ranch dressing  
1 cucumber diced  
2 cans kidney beans rinsed  
\*can add crumbled bacon\*

In a bowl, layer cornbread, corn, green pepper, red pepper, onion, tomatoes, kidney beans, cucumber, and cheese. Then add ranch dressing. Repeat layers. On top, put remaining ranch dressing and cover top with cheese and bacon. Chill for a couple hours.
