August 10: We get to honor Rickey and Joan Taylor for their service and faithfulness here. (Some of us remember Rickey's ministry here 35 years ago as well.)



#### Wandi's Corner

#### Mexican Cornbread

Recipe from Shirley Curtis and Ruth Brittain



1/2 cup self rising flour

1 1/2 cup self rising cornmeal

2 eggs well beaten

1 tsp cayenne pepper

1/4 tsp salt

1/2 medium green bell pepper

1 medium chopped onion

1/2 cup oil

1 cup cream corn

1 cup buttermilk

1 cup grated sharp cheddar cheese

Mix all ingredients except cheese. Pour 1/2 mixture into a well greased 9 x 13 pan. Sprinkle all the cheese over the mix. Pour the rest of the mixture over the cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 40-50 minutes. (Bake in a muffin pan to get more crust. These freeze well.)

#### A 10 Year Vision For FBC Clyde

## Goal 1: Send out 5 missionaries in a short term or long term mission assignment.

- Teach at least 1 missions seminar every year
- · Promote missions training opportunities
- Take a minimum of 1 mission trip in the US and 1 mission trip abroad

# Goal 3: Establish at least 1 individual discipleship program and 1 family discipleship program.

- Use Sunday nights to focus on Family Discipleship programs
- Find and implement an individual discipleship program

## Goal 5: Send out a minimum of 5 people into Christian ministry.

- Create and maintain a ministry intern program
- Allow opportunities for people who are called into ministry to preach, teach, and minister
- Create a fund to financially support ministry education

## Goal 7: Be a church in which 100% of our members are involved on a ministry team.

- Seek out new members and regular attenders and engage them into the work of the church
- Enlist new members via the FBC 101 classes

# Goal 9: Remodel our sanctuary to create a church facility that our children and grandchildren can use and be proud of.

- Begin a "Chest of Joash" fundraising campaign in January 2027
- Appoint a renovation team to make decisions

# Goal 2: Have 50 students between 6th and 12th grade in regular attendance at FBC Clyde.

- Hire and develop a student minister and provide ongoing training
- Provide 4 student trips per year

### Goal 4: Implement a minimum of 20 opportunities for biblical education.

- Have a minimum of 10 Sunday School classes
- Have a minimum of 10 in home small groups
- Maintain a minimum of Sunday morning, Sunday night, and Wednesday night services where scriptures are taught

- Incorporate a community evangelism and outreach program
- Train and equip the congregation of FBC Clyde in evangelism and discipleship

# Goal 8: Create and maintain a budget that follows biblical principles and glorifies God.

- Create a budget within the 40-30-30 guidelines
- Move to a budget that is derived from percentages of the whole budget
