


Lord and witnessing how God provided for him in every situation, kids will leave VBS with a deeper understanding of this amazing story.





electrician.




Lilly Ensley graduated from

Broccoli Salad from Madeline



5 cups fresh broccoli florets or two bags frozen

1/2 to 1 cup salted peanuts

1/2 to 1 cup raisins

8 slices cooked turkey bacon crumbled

8 oz. super fine grated mozzarella or bag

Dressing

1 cup white mayonnaise or lemonaise

1/2 cup sugar

2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar or more

Mix broccoli, peanuts, raisins, turkey bacon, and mozzarella. Make dressing in another bowl and pour on top. You may use real bacon or bits. Enjoy.

Broccoli Salad

2 bunches of broccoli destemmed

1/2 cup raisins

1 pound of bacon fried and chopped 3/4 cup mayo

1 cup green onions

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup sunflower seeds

2 tbsp vinegar

Combine broccoli, bacon, raisins, onions, and sunflower seeds in a bowl. Mix mayo, sugar, and vinegar in separate bowl. Stir sauce over broccoli mixture and let set overnight. Enjoy.
