Nothing but the Blood of Jesus


1. What can wash a - way my sin? Noth-ing but the blood of Je-sus;

 This is all my right - eous - ness, Noth-ing but the blood of Je-sus.






1. How deep the Fa-ther's love for us, how vast be-yond all mea - sure,
