## When Water is Stronger Than Stone

"...as water wears away stones..." Job 14:19

A teaching testimony of God's providence and sovereignty. **Providence** – 'pro+video', to see ahead of time; **Sovereignty** – highest, supreme.

#### **PART 1: THE STORY**

"For we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard." Acts 4:20

#### PART 2: PRINCIPLES ILLUSTRATING GOD'S PROVIDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY

1. The principle of the providence and sovereignty of God in family placement. Psalm 68:6 - "God sets the lonely in families,..."

2. The principle of the providence and sovereignty of God in our witness for him. 1
 Corinthians 3:6— "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow."
Q: In what ways can you discern your role in the lives of others bearing witness to Jesus in your life – planting seed, or watering or? Think of some examples.

3. The principle of the providence and sovereignty of God in timing. Acts 16:6-10 - "Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia. When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to. So they passed by Mysia and went down to Troas. During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, 'Come over to Macedonia and help us.' After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them."

**Q:** With whom do you sense it isn't/is the right time to share Christ?

4. The principle of the providence and sovereignty of God in prayer. Romans 8:26-27 – "The Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will."

**5.** The principle of the providence and sovereignty of God and stone hearts. Ezekiel **36:26** – "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh."
