Blessed Assurance

I John 5: 9-15

5:13: I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

Many are perplexed about whether they are in the right relationship with God and will inherit eternal life. How can we know for sure that we have been saved, reconciled to God, made right with Him, and will spend eternity in heaven?

What is our basis for knowing we have eternal life?

- 1. Our salvation is not based on our good works; we are saved by grace, not by our good deeds. Eph. 2:8-9. Jesus has paid the full penalty for all our sins. On the cross, He declared. "It is finished."
- 2. Our assurance of salvation does not rest upon our worldly success.
- 3. Our assurance of eternal life is not based on our feelings.

What is the basis for our assurance?

- 1. First and foremost, because God says so. I John 5: 11-12
- 2. Because of the ministry of the Holy Spirit within us. Rom. 8:9
- 3. Because the Bible is precious to us. Ps 119:11
- 4. Because changes occur in our outlook, attitudes, and relationships. Il Cor. 5:17
- 5. Because we love our brothers and sisters in Christ. I John 3:14
- 6. Because we want our friends and family to know Christ. II Cor. 5:20
- 7. Because we want to live godly lives. I John 3:6
