

# What's In Session?

## March 2026

Rev. Harrington called the meeting to order and called on Virginia Hager who offered a devotion and opened the meeting with prayer.

**Called Session Meeting:** A meeting is called for 9 a.m. April 19, 2026, to examine the Confirmation Class of 2026.

**Holy Thursday:** SACPC will welcome Trinity United Methodist Church, which is undergoing renovation, for our Holy Thursday service, with a social at 6:15 p.m. and the service with communion at 7 p.m.

**Discussion:** SACPC has a Global Ends Policy, or guiding principles of our church. The session evaluated the existing policy in its September 2025 retreat. Following the retreat, a task force was formed to re-examine and update the policy. The task force members are Wilbur Jones, Julian March, Rita Pasquariello, Rene Sasser, and Katie Harrington. After review, prayer, and deliberation, this task force finalized a draft document for review. The draft was positively received. Several specific wording considerations will be shared with the task force for review, with the goal of sharing an updated draft at the April Session meeting.

**Katie Harrington report:** Rev. Harrington shared:

- We're excited to be back in the sanctuary and continue to accept feedback from the congregation.
- The Presbytery of Coastal Carolina has an upcoming meeting on May 30, 2026. Rev. Parker Lucas will be preaching. The Presbytery has updated the ratio of commissioners needed to represent churches based on congregation size. Four elders will now represent SACPC as commissioners at these meetings.
