Freedom Through Resigned Hope

“Today you will be **with** me.”

Death is Relocation, Not Non-Existence

-  Our culture says the present belongs to an existence lived without hope because you are already dead and the future belongs to intelligence without bodies.
-  The gospel says life belongs to bodies filled with presence.
-  Heaven is not an upgrade away from humanity. It is humanity restored and made whole.

What death actually removes

Death removes obstacles—not connection.

Death no longer erases meaning—it confirms it.

Heaven doesn't discard what was faithful—it receives it.
