God With Us

I. Slide1 Intro:

- A. Merry Christmas to each of you! And those watching on line!
- B. Ps 40:16 May all who <u>search for you</u> be **filled** with **joy** and **gladness** IN YOU. May those who <u>love your salvation</u> repeatedly shout, **The Lord is great!**
- C. **Prayer: God**, You are **our Home**, our **destination**, and **delight**. Don't just be our North Star, but be our <u>Entire Universe</u>! Be our Immanuel, *God with us*.
- D. Slide2 Mt.1:20b-23 behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him (Joe) in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. 21 She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." 22 All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: (Is.) 23 "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us).
 - 1. This was *a descriptive title* of His earthly ministry i.e. *God with us*.
 - 2. John Wesley died w/this on his tongue. Let us live with it on our hearts.
 - 3. Matthews last sentence says, *And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age*.
- E. Slide3a Ps.84:5 says, *Blessed are those whose <u>strength</u> is IN YOU. I know that some of you are not followers of Jesus, and we are glad you are here!*
 - 1. If you don't know God intimately, I know there's times in your life where you say, I've had enough, I can't do anymore. See, if you don't know God intimately realize, all you have is ... all you have. But for Christ followers, we believe we have a strength that goes beyond just what we have. We have access to a heavenly strength. It's why the Psalmist said, Blessed are those whose strength is in You.

- F. Slide3b Believe it or not, *Christmas is for Doubters*. The Christmas narratives are filled with people who doubt.
 - 1. Here we have *a newly engaged couple* suddenly **mired in scandal** because of *Mary's divinely induced pregnancy*, a pregnancy she neither expected nor requested.
 - 2. Mary and Joseph were already the *poorest of the poor*, and now God chooses to make them **social outcasts too**?
 - 3. Of all the ways to bring the Son of God into the world, why this way?
- G. Slide4 Outline: 3 words, God With Us. (*Kids*: what 3 words?)
- II. Slide5a GOD. GOD With Us!
 - A.JESUS SO NORMAL [JESUS NOT SO NORMAL]
 - B. Mary & Joseph were so normal. Arrive in a simple town/Bethlehem, covered in road dust. Facing common problems: answering a government census, dealing with busy holiday problems trying to book an AirB&B. Found themselves in a common stable. God in her belly but no *special tax exemption*, or *spiritual dispensation* to stay home from the census. She's so normal. He's so normal.
 - 1. Don't picture: King Joseph & Queen Mary. Or even Mary & Joseph of the Bible but Norm and Norma of Normal Nazareth. 1 max lacado
 - C. Don't you feel just normal? we all are.
 - 1. Many yrs ago, back when our son & daughter were born, they showed you the Ultrasound (I'm thinking, it's cute, but where's the head?). It looked more like a Doppler Radar Storm Forecast (which maybe it was for 1 of our children :) but she's doing good now).
 - a) But now, the *Ultrasound 4D* are gettin Incredible! Slide5b
 - b) Any way, all that you want to hear from the doctor is *Everything's Normal*.
 - c) <u>Had</u> Mary and Joseph got an *ultrasound*, the doctor would've said, *He's normal*. So ... all of us *common folks* can relate!

- D. John in 1 sentence says: *And the Word/Jesus became flesh and dwelt among us* ... wait, think about it, *what an immense journey*.
- E. But wrapped in the cloak of *commonest*, is God. And God is With Us.
 - 1. He loves to come to *normal people*, through *normal circumstances*.
 - 2. And He must think really highly of you, He must think you're something special.
- F. But was also, JESUS **NOT** SO NORMAL
- G. Isaiah said *Immanuel* is coming. Matthew said <u>He's here</u>.
 - 1. Immanu*EL* with us / God. (*El, Elah, Elohim*. eg. *Daniel, Ezekiel, Samuel*)
- H. Once in Haiti, a friend was bunking with me, and we started feeding **lizards** these *winged bugs* flying around. Before long we were <u>hand feeding</u> them. But never once did I think to ask God, *Lord make me a lizard, so I might relate to them better*.
 - 1. Kids you know where Lizards live? In <u>a hole</u> of an old block wall. Under a <u>rock</u>. I wouldn't want to give up my house with heating & A/C. Or give up coffee, steak, 5 Guys burgers, or ice cream ... for little bugs???
 - 2. And give up **seeing the world**? the beach, the mountains, the desert. A lizard usually stays w/in a football fields length of where he's born.
 - 3. How far of a journey would that be, for me to become one of them a lizard?
 - a) As soon as you find an answer to that question, *multiply that by a billion*, and you'll have a fraction of what it meant for the Lord Jesus to become flesh/human and dwell among us.
 - 4. One not bound by time, to be now under its constraints.
 - a) To be everywhere present, then be limited to only where His feet would take him
 - b) To be never tired, then to fall asleep.
 - c) Never hungry now needing to nourish His body with food. GOD With Us!

A.God - is - with - us :)

- 1. Immanuel not above us, or beyond us, BUT among us.
- 2. Jesus is still with us.
 - a) God was with us/mankind in the garden of Eden. (Gen)
 - b) God will be with us in Eternity. Slide7 (Rev.21:3 And I heard a <u>loud voice</u> from the <u>throne</u> saying, Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God) with 3x's.
 - c) Slide8 And God is with us <u>now</u>, for those who have *started living in communion WITH* Him.
 - d) No temporary thing here. Always with us. Christ in you, the hope of glory.col.1:27
- B. In Immanuel the **Distant** became **near**. See Him at the carpenters bench, sitting at the well, weeping at the grave of Laz, on the cross ... *He is near! God WITH Us!*

IV. Slide9 US. God With US!

- A. WITH BELIEVERS [and with unbelievers]
- B. We gave out books called *WITH* Dec.2020 by Skye Jethani. He said, The *life with God* is a *posture* built on the view that *Relationship* is core:
 - 1. God the Father, with the God the Son, with God the HS. Trinity.
 - 2. Not surprising then that when God desired to *restore his broken relationship with people*, He sent His son to dwell *with* us.
 - 3. He chose to walk with us once again, as he did with Adam in Eden.
 - a) Jesus entered into <u>our</u> dark existence, to share <u>our</u> broken world, to illuminate a *different way forward*, *With* Jesus, 1 inch at a time.
- C. He's with us, not against Us. He is For Us.
 - 1. Psalm 23:4b I will not be afraid for You are close to me.
- D. WITH UNBELIEVERS in which way?

- E. So we (bel's) are Christ's **ambassadors**; God is making his appeal <u>through us</u>. We speak <u>for</u> Christ when we plead, "**Come back to God!**" 21 For God made Christ, who <u>never sinned</u>, to **be** the offering **for** our sin, so that we could **be made right** <u>with</u> God through Christ. 2 Cor.5:19-21
 - 1. Slide10 It's the Great Exchange: God treats Christ, like He lived your life, so He could treat us as if we lived His life.
- F. He's waiting to be with you. Are you ready to be with Him? God With US!
- G. Pray: God with us = Love with us. Hope with us. Peace with us.
