### "FAITH FLOURISHING, LOVE INCREASING" | 2 THESSALONIANS 1 | PASTOR BRIAN BELL

#### **WARM-UP QUESTION:**

If you had to grow up all over again, would you rather be an early bloomer or a late bloomer?

#### "Thanks to God for this Church" (2 Thess 1: 1-4)

Paul is thankful that God is causing their faith to grow and their love for one another to increase and He's given them patience to endure persecution. Why does an increase in faith, love and patience seem to go together for mature believers?

### "A Promise that God is Just" (2 Thess 1: 5-10)

Affliction comes to both believers and non-believers. For believers, tough times prepares them for the kingdom of God. For non-believers, judgment will come for not following God. What does patience in affliction look like for a believer? How can trusting God's judgment is coming help believers endure tough times?

#### "A Prayer to God, That He Would Make Them Worthy of His Glory" (2 Thess 1: 11-12)

Paul is praying that the Church would fulfill God's purpose for them, and that Jesus would be glorified through them. What would Jesus being glorified in someone's life look like in our culture today?

#### **REFLECTION QUESTION:**

Paul knew God had a purpose for the Thessalonians and could Him increasing their faith, love and patience through persecution so that He would be glorified. Do you believe God has similar plans for you? Are you trusting in God's ability to see you through this process and will make all things right in the end? Pray that God would "make you worthy of His calling".

## 2 Thessalonians 1

# Faith Flourishing. Love Increasing.

## I. Announce:

- A. Slide1 At Risk: Join us today 3-5pm, we spend time *praying* for the issue of HT. The fight is both *physical* and *spiritual*, so let's storm heavens gates together. See you at 3:00 pm in the Agape room.
- B. Slide2 Baby Dedication (2nd): Ana Victoria Valles. Parents: Carlos & Lili (Benjamin).
- C. Slide3 Prayer: God we know this morning you are **useful** to our lives, but we want you to be made **attractive/beautiful** in our lives.

## II. Slide4 Intro:

- A. Title: Faith Flourishing. Love Increasing.
- B. Dating: 2 Thes was written only a few months after 1st Thes. [from Corinth also 51,52ad]
- C. Problem: Someone shook them up with a letter (2:2) stating, since they were experiencing *persecutions/sufferings* they must be already **IN** *the Day of the Lord*.
- D. Their Confusion: The timing of Christ's Return.
- E. It is a letter of correction: Correcting their views on: Persecution (ch.1) Prophecy (2) Practice (3).
- F. Outline: Thanks to God, for This Church. A Promise, that God is Just. Prayer to God, that He would Make Them Worthy of His Glory.

# III. Slide5a THANKS TO GOD, FOR THIS CHURCH (1-4)

- A. Here Paul doesn't thank the church, but thanks God!
- B. Paul gives *the church of Thessalonica* **praise** for a number of things, because of what God has done in/through them.
- C. Slide5b A FLOURISHING FAITH, HOMEGROWN BY JESUS (3a) [faith growing abundantly. increasing in great amounts, above the norm. *organic growth* as of a healthy plant]
  - 1. Be not afraid of growing slowly, be afraid only of standing still. Chinese Proverb

- 2. George Macdonald, All growth that is not toward God is growing to decay.
  - a) An advancing Christian grows surer of Jesus every day.
- D. Note the **twin truths** in this ch: faith & love (3). faith & steadfastness (4). faith & power (11).
- E. A story is told of a dinner party conversation with Albert Einstein and his young neighbor, who asked the white-haired scientist, "What are you actually by profession?" "I devote myself to the study of physics," Einstein replied. The girl looked at him in astonishment. "You mean to say you study physics at your age?" she exclaimed. "I finished mine a year ago."
  - 1. Doesn't that seem how some have handled their Christianity? Some are introduced to <u>a course</u> in **salvation**, others make it <u>a life's calling</u>.
- F. Slide5c A LOVE INCREASING, BECAUSE OF JESUS (3b) [love increasing. abounding. Growing. developing] (biblical love is a decision, not just a *feeling*)
- G. Increasing = to overspread. As a fire or a flood covers everything in its path.
  - 1. Rm.5:5 the <u>love of God</u> has been **poured out** (to lavish, gush out, run greedily) <u>in our hearts</u> by the Holy Spirit who was given to us. [meditate on that!]
  - 2. Here's a great goal for **CM**, that the **love** of <u>every one of you</u> for <u>one another</u> is **increasing**.
- H.Dolly Madison (not cakes/pastries), wife of the 4th president of the US, was one of the most popular women in American history. Wherever she went, she charmed and captivated everyone <u>obscure</u> and <u>well-known</u>, <u>rich</u> and <u>poor</u>, men and women alike. She was once asked to explain the secret of <u>her power over others</u>. Surprised by the question Mrs. Madison exclaimed, "Power over people. I have none. I desire none. I merely love everyone." And those who love are <u>richly rewarded</u> by love returned.
- I. Slide5d A CONSTANCY TO ENDURE AFFLICTIONS BY JESUS (4) [they've grown spiritually, in spite of *troubles and trials*]
- J. Steadfastness endurance under trials, pressures, troubles, painful circumstances.

- 1. It doesn't just <u>passively bears things</u> that come our way, but is a **constancy** under trial. Barclay
- 2. It doesn't just endure the circumstance, but masters it.
- 3. It not only <u>accepts</u> the blows of life but in accepting them transforms them into stepping stones to new achievement.
- 4. It is not the *steadfastness* which <u>grimly waits for the end</u>, <u>but the *patience* which *radiantly hopes for the dawn*. LKGNT</u>
- K.\*Oswald Chambers, "We can never be lilies in the garden unless we have spent time as bulbs in the dark, totally ignored."

# IV. Slide6a A PROMISE THAT, GOD IS JUST (5-10)

- A. The apostle says their trials will be used to accomplish a 2-fold purpose:
  - 1. Concerning: the Persecuted (5) & the Persecutors (6).
- B. CONCERNING THE PERSECUTED (5,7,10)
- C. Their hardships will be used to prepare believers for the Kingdom of God.
- D. That you may be *considered worthy* of the kingdom of God How?
  - 1. A Christian is made *worthy* by God's grace, which he receives as a free gift by faith in Jesus Christ.
  - 2. One does not <u>earn</u> heaven by *suffering*. But *endurance in trials* does demonstrate one's worthiness.
- E. (7) Relief from tension, or slackening of pressure. [as of *a bow & arrow*. or when you loosen *a violin bow* when you put it back in its case]
  - 1. Our relief/rest comes ... when Jesus does.
- F. (10) Glorified in (not by) His saints. He will mirror His glory in us. Wow!
  - 1. 2 Cor.3:18 NLT: So all of us who <u>have had</u> that veil removed can **see and** reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord who is the Spirit makes us more and more like him as we are <u>changed</u> into his glorious image.

## G. Slide6b CONCERNING THE PERSECUTORS (6,8,9)

- H. God is *already preparing* judgment and punishment for those who <u>harm believers</u>.
- I. Since indeed God considers it just to *repay* with affliction those who afflict you
  - 1. Guaranteed, God will settle up one day, He will right every wrong.
  - 2. Slide6c \*"Not one injustice, not one act of pain, not one transaction of torture will ever be overlooked. From one little humiliation, to the horrible Holocaust, not one will be forgotten." [you have to release it]
    - a) Rom.12:19 Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but <u>leave it</u> to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord."
- J. Affliction is coming to those who *afflict*. Rest & Relief to those *afflicted*.
  - 1. Examples: Pharaoh tried to drown little babies, but <u>his own army</u> drowned in the Red Sea. Haman ended up hanging on the very gallows he made in his front yard for his enemy (75'). King Darius' advisors forced him to arrest Daniel & throw him into the lions den, later they themselves were thrown to the lions. adapted from Wiersbe
- K.(8) In flaming fire describes *His person*, not *His work*.
  - 1. Emphasizing the glory of the appearance of the Lord. Same exact wording in Rev.1:14 *His eyes were like a flame of fire*.
- L. Who does He name that His vengeance is against? [mass-murderers? Terrorists? Serial killers?] It is on those who do not know God & on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- M.Slide6d Our Gospel is based on <u>historical events</u> in a way that *other religions just* aren't.1
- N. There's a big difference between **advice** and **news**. The gospel is about **good news**, not **advice**.
  - 1. **Advice** is about counsel about something to do that *hasn't happened yet*, but you can do it. **News** is a report about something *that has happened*.

You can't do anything about it because it's been done for you and all you can do is respond to it.

- O.Eg. A king goes into battle against an invading army to defend his land.
  - 1. **If the king defeats** the invading army, he sends back to the capital city **messengers** (or *good newsers*). They go back with a good report. They say, *our enemy has been defeated and it all has been done, therefore respond with joy, and now go about your lives, conduct your lives, in this peace which has been <u>achieved for you</u>.*
  - 2. If the king does not defeat the invading army (they break through) the king sends back military advisors to the city. He says, send marksman over here, horsemen over there. We are going to have to fight for our lives.
  - 3. Every other religion <u>sends</u> military **advisors** to people. Every other religion <u>says</u> if you want your salvation you'll have to fight for your life. Every other religion is <u>sending advice</u> (*here's the rites the rituals. here's the laws and regulations*).
- P. Jesus sent **heralds/messengers**, not military advisors. [so clarifying]
  - Both advisors and messengers get an enormous response. But one is a response of Joy, and one is a response of fear.
    - a) When you **hear from a messenger** about *a historical event* that <u>has</u> happened. That's already been done for you. Salvation that <u>has been</u> accomplished for you. What do you want to do? You want to <u>obey</u> his commandments, you want to <u>pray</u>, you want to <u>please</u> The One who did this for you.
    - b) If on the other hand you **send military advisors**, saying that *you have to live a really, really, really good life* if do you want to get to heaven. What do you do? You want to <u>pray, obey</u> his commandments.
      - (1) It sounds the same doesn't it? But it's for 2 radically different reasons: one is **joy**, one is **fear**. In the short run, they look alike. In the <u>long run</u> burn out, self righteousness, and guilt and all sorts of problems.
- Q. Saints, we have not been given Good Advice, but Good News!

- R. (9) Everlasting destruction everything opposite from eternal life. [except the timing]
  - 1. It is not annihilation, but separation ... away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His might. But not from His wrath.
    - a) C.S.Lewis describes Jude's words from Jude 1:13 wandering stars for whom is reserved the blackness of darkness forever, this way: "in hell, everybody will be at an infinite distance from everybody else."
    - b) Loneliness & emptiness the extreme opposite of fellowship & fullness.
- S. This is not meanness or cruelty. This is Justice.
  - a) Ray Stedman called this, *His righteous reaction to cosmic treason on man's part.* See salvation is Exclusive. But think of it this way: *not that there's only one way, but that He made a Way :*)

# V. Slide7a PRAYER TO GOD, THAT HE WOULD MAKE THEM WORTHY OF HIS GLORY (11,12)

- A. This is the burden of **Paul's prayer** for the believers: that God might fulfill **His purpose** in their lives, and that the name of Christ might be **glorified** through them.
  - 1. Slide7b He taught the people God's truths, then prayed for them to live out what he had taught them.
- B. Paul finishes with this *breathtaking truth* that **our glory** is **in** Christ and Christ's **glory** is **in** <u>us</u>.
  - 1. Think of it this way. The glory for **teachers** lies in the <u>scholars</u> they produce. The glory for **parents** lies in the <u>children</u> they raise. The glory for **us** is given in *the tremendous privilege and responsibility* that <u>Christ's glory</u> lies **in** us.
  - 2. We may bring *discredit* or we may bring *glory* to the Master whose we are and whom we seek to <u>serve</u>.
    - a) Can any privilege or responsibility be greater than that?
- C. Keywords: faith, love, persecutors, persecuted.
