### What Child Is This?

#### I. Announce:

- A. Slide1 Selah: Due to the Christmas holiday, Selah Community Group will take a break in December. It will resume on January 27th.

### II. Slide4a Intro: What Child Is This?

- A. Our eternal destiny hangs on one question, asked here: What Child is this?
- B. Some believe he was simply a great man, a moral teacher, or a messenger of God.
  - 1. But as believers, we know the right answer: Jesus is the Son of God.
  - 2. We worship **1 God**, who has revealed Himself in **3 Persons**: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. We know that Jesus Christ is not only the Son of God, but He is also God the Son.
- C. John 1:1-2 says, *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God.*

## III. Slide5a Let's 1st ask ... WHOSE CHILD IS THIS? READ Mt.1:1

- A.[1] IT'S **JOSEPH'S** CHILD (Mt.1)
- B. Matthews gospel starts with Jesus' Foster Fathers Genealogy.
  - 1. Matthew starts his gospel by saying **Jesus** is the rightful heir to the throne of Israel. [tracing His legal right to the throne]
    - a) Racially thru Abraham [Ab.'s seed would be blessed]
    - b) Royally thru David [couldn't build God a house, but God would build a house thru him! 2Sam7:13]
    - c) Matthew (writing to the Jews) traces only back to Abraham.
    - d) Luke (writing to the Gentiles, not only to *Israel* but to *ALL humanity*) takes us all the way back to **Adam**.
      - (1) Lk's account, is **Mary's** line, Lk.3:23 [tracing Jesus' natural/physical rights to the throne].
  - Since all Jewish genealogies were <u>destroyed</u> in A.D.70, there is no Jew today who can claim w/certainty and authority to be a son of Abraham and a son of David, except <u>Jesus</u>.
- C. Joseph Foster Dad. Jesus' Real Dad.
  - 1. Often someone will **ask** *a foster dad, or adoptive dad*, about the *Real Dad*. Did he struggle with parental identity?
  - 2. Though he wasn't Jesus biological dad, he was his dad. Any different from Embryo Adoption today?
    - a) Did you know more than <u>a million</u> unused *IVF embryos* are in cryo-storage. Are they the next pro-life frontier?
  - 3. Slide5b A: What do we know about Jesus Foster dad? (Looking at Mt.1:19)

- a) Joseph takes a stand for **righteousness** (just man). And he is also **merciful** (unwilling to put her to shame)! *What a Man!*
- b) We know little of Joseph. He was a carpenter and was the son of Jacob.
- c) God knew much more about him. God knew He could *trust him* to raise His only begotten son.
- 4. A: What qualifications do you suppose God was looking for & used? [obedience, submission to His will, trustworthy]
- 5. Pre-marital pregnancy, a scandal as old as *Teen-age hormones* (Listen serious)
  - a) Deut.22:23,24 *If a young woman who is a virgin* is <u>betrothed to a husband</u>, & a man finds her in the city and lies with her, then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city, and you shall <u>stone them to death with stones</u>, the young woman because she did not cry out <u>in the city</u>, and the man because he humbled his neighbor's wife.
    - (1) Certainly he wouldn't *stone her*, but he knew he wasn't the father.
- 6. We know Joseph had to Determine what to do, so he sleeps on it!:) (20)
  - a) Like when **Peter** was able to sleep in prison, even though **Herod** was going to kill him in the morning.
  - b) Good wisdom ... sleep on it! Maybe God will give you a dream? Or just wake you up w/a way.
- D. So, Whose Child Is This? It's Joseph's Foster Child.

## E. Slide5c [2] IT'S MARY'S CHILD

- F. There were other strange ways people came into the world ....
  - 1. Adam born of dirt, with God the Fathers help of His breath.
  - 2. Eve made from a rib-bone of Adam, with God the Fathers surgical help.
  - 3. Jesus conceived in a women's womb, but with the Holy Spirits help.

- G. The miracle of the **virgin birth** was not the <u>actual</u> *birth*, but the *conception* of Christ's earthly body.<sup>2</sup>
  - This conception was not only supernatural, but unique also, for God had already performed supernatural births for "Sarah, Hannah, Elizabeth & others."3
  - 2. The Son of the Most High God umbilically tied to a lowly Jewish girl!4
- H. So, Whose Child Is This? It's Joseph's Foster Child. It's Mary's Child.
- I. Slide5d [3] IT'S GOD'S PEACE CHILD
- J. One person said it this way....
  - 1. The Father was The Author of Christmas, For God so loved, that He gave
  - 2. The Son was The Star of Christmas, His only begotten Son.
  - 3. The World was The Recipients of Christmas, for He so loved the world.
- K. Charles Wesley sang about this birth, *Veiled in flesh the Godhead See, Hail the incarnate Deity.* 
  - The Son of God becomes the Son of Man. By a real human birth He becomes a member of our race, as well as its Creator.
  - 2. **The Unseen** becomes **seen**. God emerges from heavenly hiddenness, into earthly visibility.<sup>5</sup>
  - 3. The incomprehensible SOMEONE becomes the approachable, touchable, understandable JESUS.
  - 4. The Creator becomes Savior. The greatest fact of all.
- L. So, Whose Child Is This? It's Joseph's Foster Child. It's Mary's Child. It's God's Peace Child.

# A.IT'S GOD IN-UTERO [In the womb] (Mt.1:18-25)

- 1. ... of the Holy Spirit (18,20)
- B. Slide6b Which leads us right to the 1st of 3 of His names given here.
  - 1. IMMANUEL, HIS DESCRIPTIVE NAME. (23)
    - a) A descriptive title of His earthly ministry, i.e. God with us.
    - b) Jesus is still with us. No temporary thing here. Always with us.
  - 2. JESUS, HIS HUMAN NAME (21,25)
    - a) The Greek form of the Hebrew Yashua/Joshua (a very popular name).
      - (1) It meant *Jehovah is Salvation*.
  - 3. CHRIST, HIS OFFICIAL TITLE (18)
    - a) The Greek form of the Hebrew Mashiach or Messiah. The Anointed one.
    - b) In the O.T. 3 groups were anointed: *Prophets, Priests, & Kings*.
- C. His Name Jesus also defines why He came, for he will save his people from their sins.
- D. Slide7a Our Sin has a 3-fold Repercussion:
  - 1. It Effects Our **Nature**: The Nature we're born with is enmity (actively opposed) towards God.
    - a) Albert Einstein, It is <u>easier</u> to denature plutonium than to denature the evil spirit of man.
  - 2. Slide7b It Effects Our **State**/condition: The **State** we're born in is the <u>absence</u> of Righteousness.
  - 3. Slide7c It Effects Our **Actions**: Our **Actions** become proof of our *fallen* Nature and State, when we violate or disobey the revealed will of God!
    - a) If you haven't *let go of your sins* you're holding onto *a Hand Grenade w/pin pulled out*.

- E. A: Why lies He in such *mean estate* Where ox and lamb are feeding. [mean = *unflattering, uncomfortable, even insulting circumstances* in which Jesus was born]
- F. A: Good Christian fear for sinners here The silent Word is pleading.
  - 1. [In the midst of some pretty severe "mean estate," even so, "the silent Word" was "pleading." Pleading with us. Pleading for us. Pleading that we would slow down and reflect enough to hear "the silent Word," the very presence of God with us, in the midst of "mean estate."]
  - 2. The silent Word pleads, Listen!
