"FROM GUILT TO GLORY" | JOHN 21: 1-19 | JASON HOHNBERGER

WARM-UP QUESTION: What is one of your most embarrassing moments?

"God's Grace is Bigger"

How does Simon Peter's journey from guilt to glory show how God's grace is bigger than our disgrace? What lessons about God can be learned from his transformation?

"God's Grace is Aware"

In the face of mistakes and shortcomings, how is it reassuring to know that God's grace has already factored in "stupidity"? How can this understanding impact the ability to serve and follow Jesus?

"God's Grace Qualifies"

Looking at Simon Peter's story, what are some reasons people feel disqualified or unworthy to serve God? How can people overcome these feelings and embrace God's grace in our lives?

"God's Grace Commissions"

Jesus asked Peter if he loved Him and then commissioned him to tend His sheep. What does this interaction teach us about the importance of love for Jesus and serving others?

REFLECTION QUESTION:

Despite his many blunders, Peter's life took a transformative turn when Jesus restored him to leadership after denying him during his trial and crucifixion. Peter went from guilt to glory, becoming a steadfast leader in the church and fearlessly preaching the message of redemption through faith in Jesus. **How can you demonstrate your love for Jesus through your actions and service to others this week, even in the face of past mistakes? Pray that God would give you a fresh experience of his presence that reminds you of His Grace.**
