WARM-UP QUESTION:
What is the best love song?

"It's a Love Not Based on Your Performance"

Pastor Brian points out God validates based on relationship, not on performance or accomplishment. Why is that hard to accept for many people? How can someone learn to allow God to validate them instead of something else?

"It's a Love Oriented Towards Someone"

Agape Love is a love pointed or aimed at others and for others. It's the kind of love that Jesus has for all people. If people truly believed that about God, how would that impact their view of what the Bible commands? Of what God allows in their life?

"It's a Love for Today"

In Romans 8:38-39 it says nothing in the past, present or future can separate people from God's love. It is constant and unchanging. Which is easier to believe, God's love in the past, present or future? Most difficult?

REFLECTION QUESTION:

Timothy Keller was quoted "It's one thing to believe God loves you, another thing to actually feel His love". Like any relationship, being with God takes time and being vulnerable and making yourself available and open to Him. How available have you been to God lately? Make it a point this week to remove distractions and to focus on Him.

This Is Love

I. Slide1 Intro:

- A.I liked Jamal's line, *The resurrection is beautiful we all join in this musical*.
 - 1. After 3 days in a dark hole, I picture Jesus stepping into Easter sunrise w/a warm **smile** and a **heart** <u>fueled by</u> <u>perfect-unstoppable</u>-love.
- B. Love is God's selfless gift of Himself to you this morning, in Jesus Christ.
 - 1. The Good News is a story of *love, hope and power* that kept a brutal sacrifice from being **the end**. Truly, it's just the **beginning**...
- C. **Prayer:** Lord, what a great subject we have this morning, *res love*. We know it was love *not nails* that held your son Jesus to the tree. Love that kept you in the tomb on Sat, & a love that bust-out on Sun morn. *A weekend that proved Your love. The weekend that saved the world*.
- D. **Title:** *THIS IS LOVE* ... **What** is Love??? (we could say it's His *life, death, burial, res*)
 - 1. It's a love *not* based on your Performance.
 - 2. It's a love Oriented Towards Someone.
 - 3. It's a love for Today.

II. SlideX IT'S A LOVE NOT BASED ON YOUR PERFORMANCE

- A. Eg. A voice from heaven at Jesus' baptism (b4 His ministry even started) He got the trophy before he showed up to practice.
 - 1. God doesn't validate based on performance, but on relationship.
 - 2. God doesn't validate what Jesus would do, but on who He was.
 - a) Jesus did not perform His ministry for Acceptance.
 - 3. We must learn how to receive *the Validation of God* ... each day, OR "we will need from people what they are not capable of giving us!"
 - a) How are *they* going to accept <u>you</u> unconditionally, when often times they don't even like themselves.

b) Be **validated** each day, hearing from the Father, *this is my beloved son/ daughter in whom I am well pleased.* Or as one bible put it, *This is my Son, chosen and marked by my love, delight of my life!*

III. SlideX IT'S A LOVE ORIENTED TOWARDS SOMEONE

- A. The biblical word **love**/agape is something that reflects its *orientation* towards another. (i.e. It's not self-love. It's a love *towards* another)
 - 1. Orientation (from *orient* = rising or East). *Oriented* = showing the direction in which something is aimed. [when hiking you *orient* yourself w/a compass]
 - a) Agape love is always *oriented* towards others.
- B. SlideX Pictures of Jesus foot washing [Foot Washing Series: Salt & Light]
 - What I do not know, any of these individuals relationships w/Christ.
 What I do know, is that Jesus so loves each of them, so deeply.
 - 2. God doesn't validate based on performance, but on relationship.
 - 3. Do you have *relationship* with the **Father**? Are you friend *or* family? Become part of **His family** today!

IV. SlideX IT'S A LOVE FOR TODAY

- A.Rev.1:4,5 Grace and peace to you from *the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come*; from the sevenfold **Spirit** before his throne; 5 and from **Jesus Christ**. He is the faithful witness to these things, the first to rise from the dead (referring to His historic resurrection), and the ruler of all the kings of the world. All glory to him **who loves us** and has <u>freed us</u> from our sins **by** shedding his blood for us.
- B. It's an ocean full of love. It's a perpetual present love.
 - 1. Yes God's love was for us **before** the worlds were made. A love that caused Christ to empty Himself & become obedient to the death of the cross
 - 2. And yes, there **will be** love towards us in the **future**. Think, **the love of the Bridegroom towards us His bride**. Rev.19

- 3. But stop for a minute. It's easy for me to believe that *God loved me in the past*. That God will *love me in the future*.
 - What I wanna know is, does he love me **now? Me**, for who *I really am*. Not for what I <u>do</u> for Him, or <u>might do</u> in the future for Him. Right now, with all of my *flaws*, *dysfunctions*, *mistakes*, *impurities*, *and brokenness*. Does He love me **now**?
 - a) I didn't entitle my message *This Was Love*, or *This Will Be Love*, but This Is Love.
- 4. I find it's harder for me to *trust Him* with <u>this</u> *Now* Love. Because I compare it to <u>my love</u>. I've loved others in the past that I don't love today. And I might promise to love you in the future, but let's wait and see.
- 5. I believe in His **now** love when I'm **satisfied** and **gratified**, or while I'm enjoying my health. When the sun is shining. When it's a happy day.
 - a) But it's a little more difficult when *my sky is overcast*, and all I see before me is a *tangled jungle* full of trouble, difficulties, and suffering.
- 6. But what we're talking about is *the unchanging love of Christ*. Where His love is a <u>constant</u>. *Jesus the same yesterday, today, & forever*, which means, *if He is love*, then <u>His love</u> is the same *yesterday, today, forever*.
 - a) Rom.8:35 msg Do you think anyone is going to be able to drive a wedge between us and Christ's love for us? There is no way! Not trouble, not hard times, not hatred, not hunger, not homelessness, not bullying threats, not backstabbing, not even the worst sins listed in Scripture: ... None of this fazes us because Jesus loves us.
- 7. It's one thing to believe God loves you, another thing to actually feel his love. It's one thing to believe he's present with you. It's another to actually experience His presence. Timothy Keller
- C. Prayer: Lord, Your Love Conquered death. Your Love forgives sin. Your Love makes all things new. Your Love loves to give love.

- H. The resurrection of Jesus is not just an historical fact; it's also a *lifestyle*.
 - 1. He didn't overcome death on our behalf so that we can go to heaven.

 Instead, He overcame death on her behalf so that we might live a new, vibrant, abundant, radical, and revolutionary resurrection life ... Today!
