# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

These questions are designed to help you talk about God's word and Pastor Brian's message with friends and family. You of course can use your own questions, but we'd like to give you this tool to encourage Biblical fellowship and discipleship in your circle of relationships. **Enjoy discovering more about Him!** 

### "REFLECT-RESET-REJOICE" | PSALM 90 | PASTOR BRIAN BELL

WARM-UP QUESTION: What is one word that comes to mind when you think of 2023?

#### "Reflect" Psalm 90

Moses looks over his life and others, but with humility because he is meditating on God. How could meditating on God and His character impact how you look back at the past year and look ahead to the next year?

#### "Reset" Psalm 90: 1-12

Moses points out that God is eternal but human lives are brief, and full of struggle because of sin. We need to learn to "number our days" or to live one day at a time, relying on God's new mercies. What is hard about living one day at a time? How does living one day at a time help someone be more present and purposeful instead of distracted and drifting?

#### "Rejoice" Psalm 90: 13-17

Moses asks God to "satisfy us... with your steadfast love, that we may rejoice and be glad all our days" Joy that lasts and praise come from God's love, something we experience together in His family. What are ways to receive God's love? What are ways to praise Him?

#### **REFLECTION QUESTION:**

This psalm puts God as the source of life and love. Only He can satisfy and save and give life meaning. But many people ignore God, seek satisfaction from other sources, and miss out on wisdom and joy. The key to satisfaction is to reflect on God, reset each day with His mercy, and rejoice over His love, shown ultimately in Jesus. Do you believe God can satisfy you more than anything else? How can you trust God to "establish the work of our hands" so that your life has meaning? Take time to confess your sins and then rejoice in God's love.

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## New Years 2024 Message Reflect - Reset - Rejoice

## I. Slide1 Announce:

A. Welcome to those in the Fellowship Hall and Online.

## II. Intro: Reflect - Reset - Rejoice 12-31-23

A. Often when you hear someone count **1,2,3** *something is about to happen!* (Like a toddler jumping into your arms into the pool).

- 1. It is apropos then that <u>our date today</u> is **123,123** as we start a new year, <u>because</u> ... <u>somethings is about to happen!</u>
- B. This mornings **Outline** for our New Years Message is: Reflect Reset Rejoice.
  - 1. Reflect (on 2023, what God has done). Reset (reboot today). Rejoice (in the journey, this upcoming yr has for us).
    - a) But not what *the Year* has for us (scary), but what God has planned for us!
- C. **Prayer:** Father, you loved us *all year long* with an *everlasting, unwavering love*, *without reference* to anything we <u>did</u> or <u>didn't do</u>.
  - 1. Our sorrow is <u>magnified</u> over the brokenness in the world, the brokenness in our own hearts, to the <u>unacceptable</u> plight of the <u>Unreached</u> in our world, and now to the 100 million people **displaced** in our world.
  - But our Joy and Hope are also <u>magnified</u> in all we've seen You accomplish. So we reflect on both sadness and gladness in this last year, <u>both</u> occupying appropriate *space in our hearts*. Lord, *Great is Your Faithfulness*!

## III. Slide2a **REFLECT** review 2023, what God has done.

- A. Looking back on 2023 at CM. 30,000' view, not a detail view.
- B. A few weeks ago I already highlighted our Community Outreach (Kel oversees).
- C. Outreach serving opportunities coming soon! (Jason Bell has been working on, dom & Int)

# D. Slide2b YOUTH - CK, 678, Rise High

- Growth in all 3 programs. 678 & Rise High continue to grow their Leadership and Discipleship programs. CK started Corporate Worship in in their new MPR, & started small groups for the older kids. And, expanded VBS significantly this lats year.
- E. BUILDING on FAITH Remodel & Expansion
  - 1. LC & MPR for CK were completed. Fellowship Hall is now completed.
  - 2. Sanctuary we upgraded technology for Live-Streaming and fixed our Acoustic problems (side wall *baffles*, & back wall sound treatment).
  - 3. Courtyard is getting close. (peek thru the fence)
  - 4. This time next yr we should have everything finished. (Youth building)
- F. MISSIONS General
  - 1. STM back in full swing this year. Through these teams we saw fruit in team members lives (their relationships w/the Lord and w/each other).
  - 2. Hosted a Perspectives Class: which is an *educational course* showing the <u>unique role</u>, for each Christian, in God's global purpose of *evangelizing the nations*.
  - 3. We have continued to communicate *our unique view of Missions* through our Intro To Missions Class. And to *train, teach, & equip* what missions looks like *in our world today*.
  - 4. Also, Larry was able to *meet a few H-people who are believers in Jesus* over in Asia, thanks to our friends M & L.
- G. NEPAL Property for RO
  - 1. As I think you know, we had found property to purchase in Nepal.
  - 2. What you *prob don't know* is that we were able to get our <u>funds</u> into the Nepali bank, & **closed on** 1/4 of the property. And <u>Tuesday</u> we travel over there to close on the rest & finalize paperwork on the legal side.
    - a) We also <u>funded</u> all the children to go to school (some are even in *Private Christian School*). We have numbers & names of each child.

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b) We also trained 72 adults in *computer training, mobile phone repair, pickle training*. [so we not only need to REFLECT back but also *RESET*]

# IV. Slide3 **RESET** *it's not a yearly reboot, but a daily one!*

- A.I found Moses had some rich insight 3300 yrs ago on how to do this.
  - 1. **Psalm 90**, the oldest of the Psalms.
- B. Moses spent 40 years in Egypt preparing to be <u>called</u> to ministry. 40 years in the desert preparing to <u>carry out</u> ministry. And 40 years in the desert <u>carrying it out</u>. But he never got out of the desert!
  - This was a disappointment to him. He had some <u>failures</u> in his life like we all do, but he went the distance God required, and the distance he couldn't go (promised land) ... he saw by faith.
- C. Moses answers: What is the secret to making life count?

# D. Slide4 PONDER GOD'S ETERNALITY (1,2) READ

- E. The bible declares God is the Creator of all the universe, but also that God Himself is *not created*.
  - 1. There is a crucial distinction between the Creator & the creation. Also, it is impossible for something to create itself. [call this the *self-existence of God*]
    - a) From everlasting to everlasting You are God.

# F. Slide5 PONDER MAN'S BREVITY (3-6) READ

G. What's Moses saying here? God doesn't measure time by human standards.

1. We must adjust ourselves to <u>His way</u> of time & not expect Him to *live by <u>ours</u>*.

H.(re-read vs.6) The band Kansas nailed vs.6 in 1978, *Then all we are is dust in the wind* [actually was paraphrased from Eccl.1:14 *I have seen everything that is done under the sun, and behold, all is vanity and a striving after wind*].

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- I. Slide6 PONDER MAN'S DEPRAVITY (7-12) READ
- J. Life is futile *apart from* **God** *because of its* shortness and uncertainty and God's wrath on our sin.
- K. Today we don't # our **days** ... we # our **years** (birthdays).
  - 1. Number your days means, *live <u>one day</u> at a time*. *Not guaranteed tomorrow*. Give us this day our **daily** bread.
- L. We all count something A's on report card. Video-game scores. Wins/loses. How many *likes* you have. How many *friends* you have.
  - 1. But we often go through life counting the wrong things!
  - 2. Count the *days, hours, minutes, moments* ... as we do not have an unlimited amount of them. (statistically in CA I have **16 yrs** lft) *top3 HI,NY,CA* 78/83
- M.Time is broken up into: *millenniums, centuries, decades years, months, weeks days, hours, minutes, and seconds* for the benefit of man.
  - 1. If time was 1-long-endless-day, *if we made a <u>mistake</u>, if we <u>sinned</u>, the whole would be messed up!*
  - God's great mercy broke time into small increments if we mess up today, tomorrow we will have a brand new, fresh day to start over again. (His mercy is new ... how often? ... every morning)
  - 3. <u>This</u> day has a <u>purpose</u>. The gift of <u>this</u> 24 hours has a <u>design</u>. Will we heed the design?
- N. How do you make this the greatest year? Ask this, What will I do with TODAY?

# O.Slide7 PONDER GOD'S CHARITY (13-17) READ

- P. Moses prays for *a reversal* of what has gone before.
  - Earlier he asked *return* man to dust (v.3). Now Moses says to God, return to *forgive* have <u>pity</u> on your servants (13) and return to show Your *favor* (17).

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- Q. The new year ought to <u>drive me</u> deeper into the arms of God enjoying His embrace, longing for His return, and longing for *His kingdom to come and His will to be done on earth as it is in heaven*.
- V. Slide8a **REJOICE** in the journey, in what God has for us, this upcoming year.
  - A. **CM** no matter where you find yourself **this year**, *God will be there*. No matter how strong <u>the storms</u> hit this year *God will always be there for us*.
  - B. Slide8b CM for us corporately we will be Emphasizing Fellowship in 2024:
  - C. Heb.10:25 tells us *not to neglect meeting together*. This doesn't mean only that we *gather at church services*, but that we are *devoted to relationship* with <u>one another</u>.
    - In the church-wide survey last year, you told us that you want to be more connected with each other. The Board has decided to make fellowship a <u>strategic focus</u> for a season. It is our heart that each person at CM is able to participate in godly relationships.
  - D. Slide8c What do we @ CM mean by fellowship? The common life shared among disciples of Jesus in which we reflect our relational God, leading to a deeper connection with God & w/each other through loving, caring, & worshiping together
  - E. Also, I will be *highlighting Fellowship* once a month from the pulpit.
    - 1. Eg. We will start a 2 *minute greeting* next week on Sundays.
      - a) (after worship. No, you won't be able to get into *deep relationships* in 2 min but you will at least be able to *get a name & a little bit about them* vs. "*Hi*!")
  - F. **Prayer:** Lord, *our entire Christian life* might be thought of as *a lifelong determination, to make and walk out*, *New Creation - Every Day Resolutions!* 
    - 1. God we will not lean on our *willpower*, but on the power You provide us in Your HS.
    - 2. God you have saved us by Your grace. Your mercy is for us. Your pardon is for you. Your grace is for us. Your power is for us.
    - 3. God this year we will focus on what You've done, not on what we can't do

- a) We will focus on Your power, not on our weakness.
- b) We will focus on Your strength, not on our frailty.
- c) We will focus on Your goodness, not on our badness.
