These questions are designed to help you talk about God's word and Pastor Brian's message with friends and family. "THE ROAD OF WONDER" | LUKE 2: 8-20 | PASTOR BRIAN BELL

WARM-UP QUESTION:

What is it about Christmas that can create a sense of awe or wonder?

"Wonder Interrupts Our Ordinary" Luke 2: 8-9

Shepherds were out doing their jobs when an angel of the Lord appears to them, overwhelming them. **How can an interruption** into the ordinary become a moment of awe? Why do many people miss those opportunities of awe and wonder?

"Wonder Awakens Through God's Good News" Luke 2: 10-14

The angel shares that a savior, a king has been born in Bethlehem and that this is great joy for all people. Then many angels appear praising God. How can the gospel create a sense of awe?

"Wonder Moves Us Toward Jesus" Luke 2: 15-16

The shepherds were so inspired and curious they had to go find this baby in a manger. Why is seeking a sign of true wonder? How does God inspire awe to bring people searching for Jesus today?

"Wonder Flows Out as Worship and Witness" Luke 2: 17-20

When the shepherds find the baby, they are excited and return to the fields praising God. How can sharing a sense of awe with others be a way to experience more wonder? Why is worship a common outcome of awe at what God has done?

REFLECTION QUESTIONS:

Shepherds were doing their very ordinary jobs when angels come to them, sharing the good news of the birth of the Savior, Jesus. They are filled with wonder and seek Jesus, and after finding him, return to the fields praising God. God's good news creates wonder in a way that leads to Him and results in worship. How has God inconvenienced you to get your attention? Has the gospel given you a sense of awe lately? Have you taken the time to search more of what God wants to show you? How can you make time to worship and praise Jesus in your life? Praise God for His good news this week.

5 The Road of Wonder

I. Announce:

- A. Welcome to those watching online (2nd).

- F. Prayer: May we hear Your Word clearly, feel it sensitively, and ponder it deeply.

II. Intro:

- A. Slide 17b The Road of Wonder The Shepherds' Night of Glory.
 - God often reveals His glory to the humble, the ordinary, and the overlooked - because wonder begins with awe, not status.
- B. The wonder of Christmas is not in what we bring to God, but what He brings to us.
- C. How do we Recapture Wonder?
 - 1. Children don't struggle to be impressed but we do. Christmas season 2025 is an invitation to recover Awe again.
 - 2. Picture a night sky filled with stars like, well, a silent night, a holy night where all was relatively calm until it wasn't! When Heaven ripped open!
 - a) So it was a quiet, ordinary, nothing special kinda night that turned into a night of Glory. A night of Wonder. [from Silent night to Blinding light]
 - 3. The shepherds show us that **wonder** is the doorway to **worship**.

- D. Remember, There's only 2 ways all religions explain *how to connect with God*. The Bible's way and every other way.
 - 1. The <u>distance</u> between us and God, <u>mostly because of sin</u>, <u>is closed by</u> (many think) **us ascending** unto God through: <u>morality, reincarnation</u>, good works, paying off our karmic debt, trying harder, or doing better.
 - a) It's pride! Us rising up to God, us becoming closer to God, or more like God, because of our effort?
 - 2. Christianity is about God coming down to be with us. It is not about pride but it's about humility. It's not about what we do it's about what He's done. It's not about the favor we merit, but the grace He gives!
- E. Slide 18 Read Luke 2:8-20

III. Slide19 1 WONDER INTERRUPTS OUR ORDINARY (8,9)

- A. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them....
- B. Shepherds were Living their Normal, *Unnoticed* Lives.
 - Bottom of the social ladder, overlooked, stuck doing night shift.
 "They were distrusted, a wild bunch, rural nomads, a despised class, considered unreliable, and considered unholy because they worked on a Sabbath. And God says, I choose you guys! [Chosen for the 1st birth announcement]
 - 2. Yep, the baby is revealed to, "those shepherd types". A large God for little people!
- C. These Interruptions are also Inconvenient.
 - 1. Jesus is many things but He's isn't convenient.
 - a) He makes a very pregnant teenager, do an 80 mile trip south? You and I consider any **in**convenience to our lives, a nasty negative.
 - b) When God's agenda conflicts with ours we have a choice to make:
 - (1) **Get mad** at being inconvenienced, or **Surrender** our expectations to God, and ask Him to give us His agenda for our lives.

- (2) When we do, we find the JOY of obedience in the midst of being inconvenienced.
- c) Has the Lord inconvenienced **you** lately? How did you **respond**? How will you respond in the **future**? What steps can you take to **remain** *joyful* when you're **in**convenienced?
- D. God Loves Showing Up Where no one Expects.
 - 1. Christmas *interrupts* the routine.
 - 2. Many of God's greatest works begin as holy interruptions.
 - a) Make God's interruptions invitations to Wonder.
 - 3. God sees you where you are and meets you in the ordinary.

IV. Slide20 2 WONDER AWAKENS THROUGH GOD'S GOOD NEWS (10-14)

- A. Fear not... I bring you good news of great joy for all people.
- B. The Message Begins with Grace.
 - 1. Fear not God comes *for us*, not against us.
 - a) Fear not! Why not? because there is fresh hope, and great joy, and good news. And a baby, a Savior, the Christ, the Lord.
 - 2. Good news not advice, not demands, but a gift.
- C. The Message Centers on a Savior.
 - 1. Not a political figure, not a philosopher a Deliverer.
 - 2. Born not in a palace, but a manger humility wrapped in glory.
 - 3. Baby God: **Helpless** and **Homeless**. **Helpless** (they *wrapped him and swaddling cloths*, feeble, helpless. Jesus' royal privilege stopped at conception. His mother <u>must</u> nourish and care for him, or He will die from hunger. He <u>must</u> be wrapped in *strips of cloth*, unless He freezes to death). **Homeless** (lying in a feeding trough His bassinet/crib).
 - a) What do these 2 signs teach us? God, the eternally wealthy and mighty God, enters into the most extreme poverty imaginable.

- (1) No man is **so weak** and **helpless** that God does not come to him in Jesus Christ, right in the midst of human need. And ...
- (2) No man is **so forsaken** and **homeless** in this world that God does not seek him, right in the midst of their **human distress**.

D. Heaven Explodes with Praise.

- 1. A heavenly choir declaring peace on earth. [all wasn't calm, but man it's bright!]
- 2. God isn't quiet about His Son. [listen how the writer of Heb introduces Jesus]
- E. Heb. 1:1-3 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, 2 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. 3 He is **the radiance** (a-POW-gazma the quality of sending out rays of light. As sunshine is of the sun.) of **the glory**/doxa **of God** and **the exact imprint** (Gk word *Xar-ek-TEAR*) **of his nature**, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.
- F. Remember watching a *long* falling star? *unexpected*, *brilliant*, *unforgettable*.
- G. Wonder even grows when we <u>truly hear</u> the gospel again fresh, personal, for us.

V. Slide21 3 WONDER MOVES US TOWARD JESUS (15-16)

- A.Let us go... and they went with haste.
- B. Wonder Invites a Response.
 - 1. They didn't delay, overthink, or do committee meetings.

 They just went. Wonder produces movement. (like Joe's obedience)
- C. They Found Jesus just as God Said.
 - 1. Not a throne a feeding trough. Not power vulnerability. Not us going high ... but God coming low/really low. It doesn't get any lower than being born in a dirty feeding trough. So He goes low, for the <u>last</u> and the <u>least</u>. He goes low for <u>you</u> and <u>me</u>. [God turning the world-order upside down. He comes not for the elite but for the poorest of poor]
- D. A child running to see a *Christmas tree lighting* no hesitation, just delight.

E. Wonder that doesn't lead us to Jesus is just *nostalgia*. True wonder seeks Him.

VI.Slide22 4 WONDER FLOWS OUT AS WORSHIP AND WITNESS (17-20)

- A. They made known... they glorified and praised God.
- B. The Shepherds Can't Keep It to Themselves.
 - 1. Wonder is contagious Their story becomes their ministry.
- C. Mary *Treasures*, the Shepherds *Tell*.
 - 1. Both are Worship.
 - 2. Both are ways of responding to Glory.
- D. They Return Different than they Came.
 - 1. That's what encountering Jesus does.
 - 2. Same fields, same jobs but changed hearts. Don't miss, God met them on their job site. Oh the Glory of the common place! (same today, whether you're punching #'s, chasing toddlers, or knocking on doors).
- E. When you've truly encountered Christ, worship isn't a task <u>it's</u> the overflow.
- F. Conclusion: WALKING THE ROAD OF WONDER
- G. What other profession would be more excited about *a Lamb being born*?
 - 1. Here these shepherds *leave their 99*, to locate this **1 Lamb**. The shepherds remind us: **God comes close to the humble**.
- H. The wonder of Christmas is not about what we bring... but what God brings to us.
- I. This week: Slow down. Look up. Let God interrupt your ordinary.
 - 1. Ask Him to *restore your sense of* **wonder**. The kind the shepherds *felt*. The kind that leads to Jesus.
- J. Prayer: Lord, <u>interrupt</u> our busy nights with **Your glory**. Help us recover wonder at the God who *came close*.
