Christ Is Risen

I. Slide1a Intro:

- A. Slide1b/c Spoiler alert: (whisper) The Tomb was Empty!!!
- B. Pray:
- C. This Easter I'm focusing on *Resurrection change* to one person, Mary Magdalene.
 - 1. Slide1d Ken Gire said, It was in a garden ages ago that paradise was lost, & it is in a garden now that it would be regained.
 - a) Mary Mag is mentioned **14 x's** in the Gospels. 8 of the 14 she is named w/the other ladies and she is *always mentioned 1st*. (only in 1 verse is she mentioned after Mary, Jesus' mom). The 5 x's she's mentioned alone are in connection w/*Jesus' death & res*.
 - 2. Slide2 Mary from Magdala, did have 7 demons before she met Jesus.
 - a) These *dreadful inmates* must have caused her such pain & pollution.
 - b) It was such a *horrible & hopeless* case, in which <u>she couldn't help herself</u>, nor could any human help her. She needed Jesus. Mark 16:9 *Now when He rose* early on the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out <u>seven demons</u>. **Proving**, for any of you who thought the roof might fall in if you go to church, *No depth of sin, nor possession of* numerous demons, shall separate us from the love of God!:)
 - 3. There is not a shred of evidence that she had a bad reputation.
 - 4. Slide3 Her devotion: No woman superseded her holy fidelity to the Master.
 - a) She was last at the cross. She was earliest to the grave. She was the 1st person to witness the resurrection. She was 1st to be commissioned to herald the news of His resurrection. She was never the same ... after meeting Jesus.
- D. Slide4 Read: John 20:11-18

II. Slide5 HE CALLS YOU WHEN YOU'RE W/O HOPE (11-15) READ

- A. The angels ask, why are you weeping? Jesus asks, why are you weeping?
- B. The resurrection is about ... turning *Tears into Joy* ... *Sorrow into Hope*.
- C. Think about it: Jesus could have went knocking on *Pilate's* door or could have confronted *the high priest* (*I'm back!*). But the 1st person our resurrected Lord appears to is a woman w/o hope. And His 1st words, *Woman, why are you weeping?*
 - 1. He doesn't shout His resurrection <u>from a housetop</u>, <u>instead</u> quietly to a woman who *grieves*. Who desperately needs to *hear* His voice, *see* His face, *feel* His embrace.
 - a) What a Savior we serve, *or rather*, who **serves us!** (Ken Gire)
- D. Hopelessness or Emptiness may *feel like a tomb*. Loneliness, addiction, or death of a loved one, may feel like a tomb. [Whether it's a tomb of my *own making*. A tomb of *unfairness*. Or a tomb of *past hurts*]
 - 1. Listen to this: Jesus walked out of <u>His</u> tomb, in order to walk into <u>yours</u>.
 - 2. He wants to breathe life & hope into **you** this morning. We need hope every morning. And Easter Hope ... is an every morning Hope.

III. Slide6 HE IS OFTEN MISIDENTIFIED (14,15)

- A. Supposing him to be the gardener? Well, maybe not far off, at this moment He had come into the garden to lift up *one drooping flower*.
- B. Have you *misidentified* Jesus? Some cling to a <u>safe</u> *cute lil baby* Jesus.

 Others cling to the *passive why can't all religions just get along* Jesus. Others are <u>fearful</u> of Him as the *Temple Terminator*. Others cling to a *cool* Jesus. But *He is* the *Living/Ruling/Reigning/Victorious/King of Kings* & *Lord of Lords* Jesus.

IV. Slide7 HE CALLS YOU BY NAME (16)

- A. He not only *knows* you by name, but *calls* you by name. [Jesus said in Jn.10:3, *He calls His own sheep by name*].
 - 1. What a tender moment when Jesus said, Mary!

- a) When He calls her <u>by name</u> He immediately comes into **focus**. Like when I depress my **shutter release** ½ way down on my <u>camera</u>. Focus is **immediate**. That's what happened here.
- b) Has Jesus become blurry to you? That happens to us when our eyes fill w/ tears from devastating circumstances. Everything starts to get blurry.

 Jesus gets blurry, and His voice becomes strangely unfamiliar.
- c) It's then, when Jesus just speaks your name. *And you blink away the tears of unbelief or confusion*. [wait for <u>your</u> 1-word today, where all of a sudden ya get it!]
- 2. And then Mary's recognition of Him and cry in her heart language/Aramaic, Rabboni/teacher. Most rabbi's wouldn't teach women back then. But the 1st word that comes to the disciple Mary's mind, Rabboni! (there was a saying that a disciple "was to be covered by the dust of his rabbi.")
- 3. It's one of the emotional highlights of the entire Gospel. (Shepherds Notes; pg.89)

V. Slide8 HE SENDS YOU ON A MISSION (17,18)

- A. Augustine, the 4th-cent orthodox theologian, gave Mary Magdalene the honorific title "Apostle to the Apostles". [apostle = one divinely sent]
- B. Mary was not to be *clinging* to Him, but she was to go and give His message.
 - Last month a number of us got to go see the empty tomb In Israel.
 But we are not called to linger there, nor make a shrine out of it, but are to go declaring the fact of it!
 - 2. Mary was changed from a **mourner** to a **missionary** when she met the living Lord.
 - a) Jesus interrupts this precious moment by giving her a pressing errand to run. And run she does with the *1st Easter Sermon*, *I have seen the Lord!*
- C. Like Mary, we should live our lives at the foot of the cross. Stand in front of the empty tomb. Have faith in His resurrection. And tell the world, *I have seen the Lord*. How?

1. I have seen the Lord in my life change. I have seen the Lord in my worship time. I have seen the Lord in my bible reading. I have seen the Lord in my life. I have seen the Lord in friends and family members lives.

- E. Slide9 Mt.28:9 And as <u>they</u> (2 Mary's) went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, <u>Rejoice!</u> So they came and <u>held Him</u> by the feet and <u>worshiped Him</u>.
 - 1. Rejoice, our Happy Source in the Resurrection of our Jesus.
 - 2. Rejoice, in a transformation only Jesus can bring you.
 - a) A lizard w/snorkel gear, is *not equal to* a **frog**. And neither is...

 A caterpillar that *clips a set of wings* on its back, then calls itself a **butterfly**.
 - b) An *inward* transformation must take place. Same with us.
 - c) We must be born *from above*. Christ must <u>invade our life</u>, & <u>perform a creative act</u>, a *metamorphosis transformation*.
 - d) And what a caterpillar calls the end, the rest of the world calls a butterfly.
 - e) Are there any caterpillars this morning that would like to become a butterfly?
- F. In this last song, the 2nd bridge is us saying, *I'll witness it*.
 - 1. To the **broken** I'll witness it. To the **hurting** I'll witness it. To the **lost** I will witness it. And I'll tell them this. I'll tell them what I've witnessed.
 - 2. To my **family** I'll witness it. To my **city** I'll witness it. To the **nations** I'll witness it. And I'll tell them this. I'll tell them what I've witnessed.
