Always Winter - Never Christmas

- I. Slide1,2a Intro: [welcome: gym] (TY Jen, Cheryl, Danica, Chris S, CW & team)
 - A. Advent/arrival is marked by *hope*, *peace*, *joy*, *and love*. All of these are a *universal longing*. We all want to love, and be loved. [invitation at the end to receive this Love]
 - 1. Since we didn't get to do the 4th-Love this year. My Christmas verse for this year is about love, and one you might have heard of it before.
 - B. Illust: As a group of college students toured the **slums** of a city, one of the girls, seeing a <u>little girl playing in the dirt</u>, asked a guide, "Why doesn't her mother clean her up?" "Madam," he replied, "that girl's mother probably loves her, but she doesn't hate dirt. You hate dirt, but you don't love her enough to go down there and clean her up. Until hate for dirt and love for that child are in the same person, that little girl is likely to remain as she is.
 - 1. God did both for us, He hates sin/our dirt & loves people/you & I.
- II. Slide2b Christmas Theme: Always Winter Never Christmas. (note Donkey)
 - A. This title was taken from the 1st of 7 novel's by CS Lewis, in his Chronicles of Narnia (*The lion, the witch, the wardrobe*). It is set in the fictional realm of Narnia, filled with talking animals and mythical creatures.
 - 1. It's about a curse that could never be lifted ... until Aslan (Aslan represents Christ in this Christian allegory). Narnia was ruled by an evil witch. She had cast a spell on Narnia that caused it to be Always Winter But Never Christmas however there was a prophecy that her rule would be broken by 4 humans (Lucy, Edmund, Susan, Peter).
 - B. Sometimes LIFE feels like *Always Winter, Never Christmas*. Covid feels like *Always Winter, Never Christmas*. A dead end job feels like *Always Winter, Never Christmas*.
 - C. See we live in a world where there is *a curse*, where there is *winter* and *cold* and *darkness*. Where there is *pain* and *hardship*. Yet, ever before us is the promise of Christmas: that Jesus has come to the world to save us.

- D. Christmas is that bright spot in the middle of winter, that somehow makes it all worth it.
 - 1. You know, you don't have to be *a believer* to *like Christmas*. I think we have the best holiday! (Hanukkah/dreidel/jelly donuts). Maybe because it's marketed of the best. *Christmas movies/Elf, Christmas songs, gift giving, lights*. Christmas is that bright spot in the middle of winter, that somehow makes it all worth it.
 - 2. But, What if there were no Christmas? What if the Christmas season never came? Think about it: no holiday decorations, no family gatherings, no Christmas lights, no Christmas carols or concerts, no Christmas trees, no Christmas presents ... Kids, that means no Christmas vacation!
 - a) Christmas is the gift we want, but Jesus is the gift we need!
- E. Our world is under a curse (of sin) and the whole creation is waiting for that curse to be lifted. It's a world that *is not as it should be*, and *awaits restoration*.
 - 1. God created our world **good**, and yet because of Satan and Sin, our World is not as it should be. We are not as we should be.
 - 2. We are prisoners of sin, locked up, needing rescue. We need a Savior!
- F. So, my Christmas verse for this year about love is *John 3:16*.
- III. Slide3 JOHN 3:16 aka, the good news in miniature.
 - A. For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.
 - B. 4 God...the greatest Lover. The Father <u>initiated</u> all of this.
 - C. 5 So loved...the greatest degree.
 - NOT...God so...manipulated the world. Or finally broke the world. Or disciplined the world. Or punished the world. Or scourged the world ... until people responded to Him.
 - 2. His love does not exist because of our character, but on account of His.

- 3. God does not love us because we are valuable, we are valuable because *God loves us*. God does not love us because Jesus died for us, but Jesus died for us because *God loves us*.
- D.6 The world...The greatest number. His divine care for the entire world. [hello missionaries]
 - Not just the Jewish nation. Not just the elite, rich, powerful, but the unlovables & untouchables, the one's that detest God, the ones that are too busy for God, the ones too rich for God, or working against God.
- E. 7 That He gave...the greatest act.
 - 1. The *measure* of love is always its *willingness* to **give**, its *capacity* for **sacrifice**. Is.9:6 For to us a <u>child</u> is born, to us a <u>son</u> is **Given**. [humanity/diety]
- F. 8 His only Son...the greatest gift. Jesus is a GIFT.
 - We can never know the costliness of Calvary to God, nor can we ever measure the love that lay behind it.
 - 2. It was free but not cheap. It didn't cost us anything It cost Him everything
- G.9 That whoever... the greatest invitation. (you are a whoever)
- H. 10 Believes...the greatest simplicity.
 - 1. It means *placing* one's life & trust in *complete surrender* to the One in whom we *believe*.
 - 2. Not trying to come up with the right feeling, or the right type of faith.
 - 3. It is not our faith, but Christ who saves!
- I. 11 In Him...the greatest Person, Jesus!
- J. 12 Should not perish...the greatest deliverance.
- K. 13 But...the greatest difference. (between: perishing & eternal life)
- L. 14 Have...the greatest certainty. [it becomes our *present possession* (have).
- M.15 Eternal life...the greatest possession.
 - 1. Should not perish but have eternal life. That's Jesus' double promise.
 - 2. And not just quantity later, but quality now.
- N. 16 That whoever believes in Him... the greatest invitation.

- 1. He will take away our sin (our offenses against a perfect/holy God).
- 2. He will take away our **guilt** (the things we have **done**).
- 3. He will take away our **shame** (who we **are**).
 - a) See, I know where a **poor person** has a **chance**. Where a **sick person** can **get well**. Where an **ignorant person** can become **wise**. Where a **bad person** can be made **good**. Where a **good person** could be **made better**. Where a **dead person** could be made **alive** ... *In Jesus Christ*.
- O. Slide17,18 I can't wait for it to shift from *Always Winter Never Christmas*, to *Always Christmas Never Winter*. [where God wipes away every tear, & no more death, sorrow, crying or pain]
- P. **Invitation:** When Jesus comes His 2nd time, *the long, dark spell of winter will be broken*, and the *newness of spring* will arrive in all its beauty. *God offers this new life for all who believe*.
- Q. See, the story of *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe*, is in reality it is our story.
 - 1. When the spell of the White Witch is broken, the melting begins!
 - a) **Sin** *melts away*. The **hardness** of your heart starts to *defrost*. And your **soul** finds its worth ... in *Jesus!*
 - 2. Jesus didn't come into the world to Kill the world, but to Cure the world.
 - 3. Jesus didn't come into the world to <u>say</u>, *you're doing it all wrong*, but to show *how to do it right*.
 - 4. There are only 2 possible *responses* to Jesus: belief or unbelief.

 There are only 2 possible *destinies* to which those responses lead: eternal life or eternal death [choose life today!]
