Colossians 3:1-17

1. The sermon started out explaining how we live in this tension between the present age and the age to come. Kevin asked us, “how do we as Christians transition into the “age to come.” What’s your response to this question?
2. The beginning of our text encouraged us to “set our hearts and minds on things above.” (v. 1-2). What would this look like for you?
3. Kevin stated that, “the truest thing about us is that our lives are hidden in Christ.” Do you agree, and if not, how can you remind yourself of this fact?
4. The passage described behaviors of our earthly nature we must put to death. Which of these do you most need to rid, to better live out your life in Christ?
5. The passage then exhorts us to clothe ourselves with a list of godly virtues. Which of these resonates the most with you?

6. What would it look like for you to, “let the peace of Christ rule in your heart?” (v.15a)

7. The sermon concluded with four ways we can “put to death whatever belongs to our earthly nature.”

- Embrace discomfort
- Accept discontentment living in the world
- Immerse ourselves in the life of Christ
- Put on love
