Word of God became powerful and practical to you in a season of discouragement?

- 6. What do we need to know to become good encouragers?
- 7. Read 5:3-4. How does God use opposition and crisis in our lives to accomplish his purposes?
- 8. Describe a time when you felt "sheep dipped" by God. With the huge gap between our Great Shepherd and his sheep, what can we understand and not understand as we go through difficult seasons in life?
- 9. How does the picture of the "Eye of God" and the Doctrine of God's Sovereignty help us during hard times? How can your group specifically pray and support you in the season you are in right now?
