1. What was your life like when you were in Kindergarten? What memories, toys, and relationships shaped your Kindergarten world?
2. Describe how an event or season in your life has compelled you to cling to the Sovereignty of God in a deeper and more appreciative way?
3. Read vv. 1-2. How do the words “reign”, “majestic”, and “throne” help you understand who God is and what he has done for you?
4. Read vv. 3-4. What are the noises today that “rise like a flood or crashing waves around you?”
5. How does the truth that “God walks with us through the rising waters” help us in these chaotic times? (Isaiah 43:2)
6. How would you encourage someone who is facing a rising flood from Psalm 93?
7. Read v. 5. Why do you think the Psalmist reminds us of God’s statutes and His holiness in a Psalm that’s main theme is about His sovereign reign?
8. How does it help give us a proper perspective on evil when we remember that in the end the Lord will triumph?
9. If our Heavenly Father was to ask us, “Who am I? Why do I matter to you?,” what answers would you give Him in light of Psalm 93?
