

## January 21, 2024 Kevin Sneed Colossians 2:6-23

- 1. Kevin's sermon from our text talked a lot about our identity and position in Christ. To not just believe in this new reality but move and live in it. What would this look like for you?
- 2. It was explained how we can know information *about* Jesus, yet not really *know* him relationally. In what ways can you grow to know Him more intimately and personally?
- 3. "Fine sounding arguments," hollow words, and human teaching were introduced. These can *seem* true but lure us away from Christ and His message. How can you guard yourself and your loved ones from this deception?
- 4. Kevin shared how we're all tempted to believe "another gospel" (ex: getting a better job, relationship, material possession) will satisfy and fulfill us. In what area of your life are you susceptible to this?
- 5. "What Christ says about me is the truest thing about me." Do you believe this to be true?
- 6. Kevin made a quote that, "grace cuts across logic?" Can you recall a time when you've experienced this?

7. The sermon concluded by laying out where we may find our identity elsewhere other than Jesus Christ: (1. Achievements, 2. Possessions, and 3. Our deepest failures/greatest successes) What would it look like for you to remind yourself that "Jesus is the only treasure that's died for me," and how can the group be praying for you to internalize and hold fast to this?
