- 1. Read Exodus 1:1-8. What are some observations you see that you can share with your Community Group?
- 2. Using two quotes from Bono to illustrate, Kevin said, *"Two liberations are needed, the external and the internal. And both are true for Bono and for you and me."* Discuss how both an external and internal liberation might apply to you personally.
- 3. What difference does it make for us to understand that Exodus is a continuation of Genesis and that Exodus is fundamentally about you and me?
- 4. The New Testament gospel writers refer often to Exodus. How did Jesus' life and work ultimately fulfill the promise of Exodus?
- 5. Read Romans 8:18-21. How does the reality of a coming day when all of creation will be redeemed and restored provide encouragement for us today?
- 6. Kevin said, *"Exodus is about getting out of Egypt and getting Egypt out of us."* How does this help us understand our Rule of Life and our apprenticeship to Jesus?
- 7. What comes to mind when you think about an area of your life where you need liberation "from Egypt"?
- 8. How might your Community Group help you realize more and more the liberation and renewal that God offers you today?
