- 4. Describe an experience in which you or someone you care about was excluded because of favoritism/prejudice. How did that experience impact you?
- 5. Describe an experience in which you knowingly or unknowingly perpetuated favoritism/prejudice. In what ways have you changed since then? In what ways are you the same?
- 6. How does this type of action/attitude conflict with the kingdom of God (v.5)? Why is this action/attitude sin (v.8-11)?
- 7. What is the alternative way that James proposes (v.12)? How does the Law that gives freedom empower us to obey the teachings of James?
- 8. What is one specific step you can take this week to attack favoritism and promote mercy?
