- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 7:6-9. Paul describes how each has their own gift. Not everyone is called to singleness and not everyone is called to marriage. How can singles teach married people how to better love Jesus? How can married people teach singles how to better love Jesus?
- 5. Read 1 Kings 17:7-24. What does this story teach you about how to treat widows and other singles by force.
