God Will Sort It Out

Intro: Does the church do anything besides what happens on Sunday mornings? There is a tremendous amount effort that goes in, on a daily basis, to share the gospel with the world both in word and deed. This means organizations that are working to rescue the most marginalized people in the world such as She Is Safe which rescues girls from human sex trafficking.

Story: One of the main things shared today was about how women have a need to be rescued from the evil of trafficking. What was it that you needed God to rescue you from and how did he do it?

Read: Exodus 22:21-23

- 1. God frequently tells his people to care for the foreigners, the orphans, and the widows. What do these people all have in common?
- 2. Read Psalm 139. What does God think about the sanctity of human life and how should we value human life?
- 3. Read Matthew 25:31-46. Who are the least of these in Kings County? Who are the least of these in the world?
- 4. Many of us think that we don't have time to help with organizations. A great starting place is prayer. Collectively with your group, consider one local and one global organization you can pray for. Make a commitment to pray every single day for both organizations for a whole month.
- 5. What is one thing you can change in your life to be more of a tangible light of Jesus to a broken world?
