This Sunday at CMPC...

This Sunday we continue our preparation for the upcoming Mission Conference 2023: *The Name Above All Names* as Pastor Ben looks at III John 1-8 and *God's Family Loves to Work Together for the Family Name*. Then on Sunday evening Pastor John continues our series *on Luke: Becoming Certain About the Story* as he looks at *The Age of Anxiety* from Luke 12.22-34 to close out the Lord's Day.

Our hymns Sunday focus on Jesus' name and missions. We will gather with a 20th century hymn, *No Other Name*. Our hymn of praise is a 21st century Getty/Townend hymn, *May the Peoples Praise You*, a former conference theme song. We go back to the 20th century for our hymn of testimony, Song for the Nations, and then respond to God's word with Take My Life, and Let It Be. This 19th century classic hymn was written by Francis Havergal. We know that her spiritual journey began early in life, memorizing passages in the Bible at age 4 and writing verse by age seven. She was nurtured by her father, an Anglican clergyman, also devoted to Christian hymnody. Though Havergal's health was frail and she lived barely 43 years, she learned several modern languages as well as Hebrew and Greek. She was also a singer of some note and known as an accomplished pianist. Havergal attempted to live a life fully consecrated to Christ and to those she saw in any physical or spiritual need.

Truly that's the challenge we have as we consider how we respond to our 2023 Mission Conference!
