# This Sunday at CMPC...

This Sunday Pastor John looks at *Turn the World Upside Down!* from Acts 17.1-9, completing our sixweek mini-series *The Future is as Bright as the Promises of God.* Then on Sunday evening Pastor John will be looking at Genesis 46 *and Jacob: Into the Unknown* in our series *Joseph: When Dreams Come True.* Please remember that there will be a congregational meeting after the 830 service to concur with Pastor John's retirement.

Sunday morning's hymns focus on the gospel and our great God. There will be two 21st century hymns, a classic early 20th century hymn, and a classic 18th century hymn. The new hymns are Behold, Our God from the Sovereign Grace team, and Come, People of the Risen King from the Townend/Getty team. The classic hymns are J. Wilbur Chapman's 1910 hymn Jesus! What a Friend for Sinners and Augustus Toplady's 1776 hymn Rock of Ages. Stephen Nichols reminds us about the wonderful line in Rock of Ages that tells us how Christ is the "double cure" for our sin. The guilt of our sin puts us under the wrath of God, and the power of sin causes us to do things we don't want to do. But Toplady has us clinging to Christ, that rock of ages who is our double cure, freeing us from both sin's power and sin's guilt. All four hymns have rich words to sing about our great God.

Pray that God will be honored as we worship him this week... and pray that he would be pleased to send revival on his church!

# **The Method God Uses**

- People going deliberately with the gospel to new cities.
- Proclamation of the scriptures for three Sabbath days.
- Methodology
  - He reasoned from the scriptures: the message was bible based
  - o Explained- Luke uses only one other time: Jesus to the disciples on the Road to Emmaus
  - o Proved- setting out in order and displaying

Note: God's word- Deuteronomy 32.46-47; Ezra 7.10; I Thessalonians; Psalm 1

# The Message God Uses

- Gospel
- Jesus the Messiah
- Suffering and resurrection

#### The Impact God Uses

- Response from: some Jews, lots of Gentiles, women
- Jealous response
  - Opposition arises, mob hired
  - Sets the city in an uproar.
    - This is AD 50, and Claudius had expelled all the Jews from Rome following riots associated with Jews and Christians. Very likely the Jewish opposition would have pointed to this as a way to get rid of Paul
- Charge: Turning the World Upside Down
  - Another King: Jesus

- Blasphemy from the Jewish viewpoint; treason for a Roman
- The upside down gospel of the kingdom
  - What Nebuchadnezzar saw, Daniel
  - o The people disturbed
  - The gospel is a game-change
- Radical change evident
  - o Turned from idols
  - o Become people of hope
  - Turned from sexual immorality
  - o First century pagans viewed death with horror.
  - Persecution's reality- the world thinks that will stop the gospel; history shows just the opposite.
  - Quiet lives
