Revelation cannot be divorced from the rest of the Bible.

Revelation is a book about the person of Jesus.

Jesus is the main character in the Old Testament

Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures. Luke 24:27

Jesus was the fulfilment of the Law.

Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith. Galatians 3:24

Jesus was the fulfilment of the Messianic prophecies.

But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. Isaiah 53:5

Jesus was the fulfilment of many of the Old Testament themes.

The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! John 1:29

Jesus is the main character in the New Testament throughout the Gospels.

Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book, but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name. John 20:30–31

Jesus is the main character in the Book of Acts.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth. Acts 1:8

Jesus is the main character in the Epistles.

To whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Colossians 1:27

Jesus is the main character and the central theme of the book of Revelation.

Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice Revelation 5:11

"Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing." Revelation 5:12

The book of Revelation is God's final word concerning the person of Jesus Christ.

I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues which are written in this book; Revelation 22:18

And if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are written in this book. Revelation 22:19

The book of Revelation is a prophecy concerning the return of Jesus Christ.

The book of Revelation was written to give comfort to the church concerning the return of Christ.

When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "Do not be afraid; I am the first and the last, Revelation 1:17

And the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades. Revelation 1:18

The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His bondservants, the things which must soon take place; and He sent and communicated it by His angel to His bond-servant John, Revelation 1:1

Are you ready for the return of Jesus? Is your testimony in order?

Who testified to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, even to all that he saw. Revelation 1:2
