1. Have you become comfortable with your sin?

4. Are you more concerned about impressing others or influencing them?

5. Would you rather be poor in His kingdom or rich in yours?

Store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Matthew 6:20

6. Do you have a log in your eye?

Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you. Matthew 7:1-2

7. Do you call Him Lord but He isn’t?
