You will never finish strong if you get comfortable with being comfortable.

Being comfortable with being comfortable should be the most uncomfortable place for a believer.

# **Deuteronomy 29:1**

These are the words of the covenant which the Lord commanded Moses to make with the sons of Israel in the land of Moab, besides the covenant which He had made with them at Horeb.

## What is the danger in getting comfortable in our walk with God?

### **Deuteronomy 29:4**

Yet to this day the Lord has not given you a heart to know, nor eyes to see, nor ears to hear.

## **Deuteronomy 29:5**

I have led you forty years in the wilderness; your clothes have not worn out on you, and your sandal has not worn out on your foot.

## **Deuteronomy 29:6**

You have not eaten bread, nor have you drunk wine or strong drink, in order that you might know that I am the Lord your God.

#### **Deuteronomy 29:9**

So keep the words of this covenant to do them, that you may prosper in all that you do.

# Deuteronomy 29:14–15

Now not with you alone am I making this covenant and this oath, but both with those who stand here with us today in the presence of the Lord our God and with those who are not with us here today.

You will never finish strong if you refuse to take responsibility for your decisions, fail to build accountability and protect yourself from yourself.

### Deuteronomy 29:16-17

For you know how we lived in the land of Egypt, and how we came through the midst of the nations through which you passed; moreover, you have seen their abominations and their idols of wood, stone, silver, and gold, which they had with them.

### **Deuteronomy 29:18**

So that there will not be among you a man or woman, or family or tribe, whose heart turns away today from the Lord our God, to go and serve the gods of those nations; that there will not be among you a root bearing poisonous fruit and wormwood.

### **Deuteronomy 29:19**

It shall be when he hears the words of this curse, that he will boast, saying, 'I have peace though I walk in the stubbornness of my heart in order to destroy the watered land with the dry.'

You will never finish strong unless you learn to trust God with the things that are revealed and the things that are not.

# Deuteronomy 29:29

The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of this law.
