### **Matthew 28:18–20 (CSB)**

<sup>18</sup>Jesus came near and said to them, “All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth.

<sup>19</sup>Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

<sup>20</sup>teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

### **Matthew 22:34–40 (CSB)**

<sup>34</sup>When the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they came together.

<sup>35</sup>And one of them, an expert in the law, asked a question to test him:

<sup>36</sup>“Teacher, which command in the law is the greatest?”

<sup>37</sup>He said to him, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.

<sup>38</sup>This is the greatest and most important command.

<sup>39</sup>The second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.

<sup>40</sup>All the Law and the Prophets depend on these two commands.”
