Jesus Is The Everlasting King Over Everything.

### **Luke 19:28–36 (CSB)**

<sup>28</sup>When he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.

<sup>29</sup>As he approached Bethphage and Bethany, at the place called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of the disciples

<sup>30</sup>and said, “Go into the village ahead of you. As you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it.

<sup>31</sup>If anyone asks you, ‘Why are you untying it?’ say this: ‘The Lord needs it.’ ”

<sup>32</sup>So those who were sent left and found it just as he had told them.

<sup>33</sup>As they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, “Why are you untying the colt?”

<sup>34</sup>“The Lord needs it,” they said.

<sup>35</sup>Then they brought it to Jesus, and after throwing their clothes on the colt, they helped Jesus get on it.

<sup>36</sup>As he was going along, they were spreading their clothes on the road.

Jesus’s power will never fade.

Jesus’s kingdom will never end.

Jesus’s reign will never stop.

### **Luke 19:37–40 (CSB)**

<sup>37</sup>Now he came near the path down the Mount of Olives, and the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles they had seen:

<sup>38</sup>Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heaven!

<sup>39</sup>Some of the Pharisees from the crowd told him, “Teacher, rebuke your disciples.”

<sup>40</sup>He answered, “I tell you, if they were to keep silent, the stones would cry out.”
