### **Mark 4:35–41 (CSB)**

<sup>35</sup>On that day, when evening had come, he told them, “Let’s cross over to the other side of the sea.”

<sup>36</sup>So they left the crowd and took him along since he was in the boat. And other boats were with him.

<sup>37</sup>A great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking over the boat, so that the boat was already being swamped.

<sup>38</sup>He was in the stern, sleeping on the cushion. So they woke him up and said to him, “Teacher! Don’t you care that we’re going to die?”

<sup>39</sup>He got up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, “Silence! Be still!” The wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

Turn to Jesus First

### **What Should We Do In Chaotic Situations?**

Trust Jesus Fully

#### **Mark 4:39-41 (CSB)**

<sup>39</sup>He got up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, “Silence! Be still!” The wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

<sup>40</sup>Then he said to them, “Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?”

<sup>41</sup>And they were terrified and asked one another, “Who then is this? Even the wind and the sea obey him!”

Jesus may not remove you from a chaotic situation but he will lead you through it.
