Titus 1:1-2

To Titus, my true child in a common faith: I left you in Crete, that you would set in order what remains and appoint elders in every city as I directed you.

Titus 1:4-5

Holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching, so that he will be able both to exhort in sound doctrine and to refute those who contradict.

Titus 1:9

For there are many rebellious men, empty talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision, who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, teaching things they should not teach for the sake of sordid gain.

Titus 1:10-11

They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.

Titus 1:16

But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.

Titus 2:1

Holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching, so that he will be able both to exhort in sound doctrine and to refute those who contradict.

Titus 1:9

Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in perseverance.

Titus 2:2

Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good.

Titus 2:3

So that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children.

Titus 2:4

To be sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored.

Titus 2:5

Likewise urge the young men to be sensible; in all things show yourself to be an example of good deeds, with purity in doctrine, dignified.

Titus 2:6-7

Sound in speech which is beyond reproach, so that the opponent will be put to shame, having nothing bad to say about us.
