Christians need prayer like people need air.

Matthew 6:9–13 (CSB)

⁹ Therefore, you should pray like this: Our Father in heaven, your name be honored as holy.

- ¹⁰Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
- ¹¹Give us today our daily bread.
- ¹²And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
- ¹³And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

God is the perfect Guide who knows the destination and is able to lead you there.

1. God protects us from dangers on the path.

Ephesians 6:12 (CSB)

¹²For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this darkness, against evil, spiritual forces in the heavens.

John 10:10 (CSB)

¹⁰A thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance.

2. God warns us from wandering off the path.

Galatians 5:16-17 (CSB)

¹⁶I say, then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh.

¹⁷For the flesh desires what is against the Spirit, and the Spirit desires what is against the flesh; these are opposed to each other, so that you don't do what you want.

Psalm 119:105 (CSB)
