## Matthew 4:18-22 (CSB)

<sup>18</sup>As he was walking along the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter), and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen.

<sup>19</sup>"Follow me," he told them, "and I will make you fish for people."

<sup>20</sup>Immediately they left their nets and followed him.

<sup>21</sup>Going on from there, he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat with Zebedee their father, preparing their nets, and he called them.

<sup>22</sup>Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

- 4. Cast the net deep and wide.

#### 1 Peter 4:10-11 (CSB)

<sup>10</sup>Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God.

<sup>11</sup>If anyone speaks, let it be as one who speaks God's words; if anyone serves, let it be from the strength God provides, so that God may be glorified through Jesus Christ in everything. To him be the glory and the power forever and ever. Amen.

## 2 Timothy 4:2 (CSB)

<sup>2</sup>Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; correct, rebuke, and encourage with great patience and teaching.

## Acts 8:4 (CSB)

<sup>4</sup>So those who were scattered went on their way preaching the word.

## 1 Peter 3:15 (CSB)

<sup>15</sup>but in your hearts regard Christ the Lord as holy, ready at any time to give a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you.
