DIGGING IN: Read Acts 2:41-47

- 1. What is the most impressive thing to you in this passage of Scripture?
- 2. Lots of adjectives are used to describe the relationship these new Christians/church members had with each other, but in a sentence or two how would you describe their mutual relationship?
- 3. V:46 includes the phrase "from house to house."
- a. What does that phrase suggest about how these new believers were "doing" church?
- b. What significance do you see in that phrase for the 21st century church?

DIGGING DEEPER:

- 1. Tell the rest of your group why you are glad you belong to this Life Group.
- 2. Life Group has several elements to it as listed below. Over the last 4 weeks select two from the list that especially blessed you.
- a. Gathering (shutting off all other activities for 90 minutes)
- b. Listening
- c. Discussing and applying Scripture
- d. Sharing needs
- e. Prayer
- f. Other
