Week of: March 14-20, 2021 Text: Acts 2:42-3:26

GETTING STARTED:

What has been your favorite job to work? What made it your favorite? How did you get it and if you left it, how did you leave it?

Same question, other direction. What has been your least favorite job to work? What made it your favorite?

DIGGING IN:

Read Peter's Speech in Acts 3:11-26 and make a note/list of all the references her makes to the Old Testament.

Peter mentions that Moses wrote about a "Prophet who would come after him"—read Deut. 18:15-22. What do you notice about this passage? What does this passage tell us about Moses, about God, and about God's plan?

Peter mentions that the Messiah would "suffer"—read Isaiah 53. What do you notice about this passage? What does this passage tell us about the Prophet, about God, and about God's plan?

DIGGING DEEPER:

The Believers in Acts 2:42-47 are noted for doing four things: 1) Studying (devoting themselves to the Apostles' teachings), 2) Meeting Needs/ Serving (sharing possessions), 3) Fellowshipping (breaking bread), and 4) Praying.

- Which one of these practices would come most natural for you?
- Which one of these practices is less natural for you?

• Which one of these practices would you like to see the group implement or grow toward in the next few weeks?
