Week of: December 27-January 3, 2021 Text: Joshua 24:1-28, Judges 2:10

GETTING STARTED:

Do you have a favorite story that your parent or grandparent shared with you from their childhood/life? Why does that story stick with you?

DIGGING IN:

- 1. Are you sentimental or do you like to leave the past in the past and move on?
- 2. How important is reflection to you? Do you take time to reflect? Is that a part of your day, week, or do you miss this with the business of life?
- 3. What benefits do you find in spending time in reflection?

DIGGING DEEPER:

- 1. One of the last things Moses and Joshua did before they died was to share what they had seen God do for the Israelites in their lifetime. What do you think the significance of that was?
- 2. Why do you think they did that?
- 3. In Judges 1 and 2 it is clear that we are picking up in time where the book of Joshua left off, Joshua had just died and just one generation after him we find that there is a generation who knows not the Lord. Do you think that could happen today, is it happening today?
- 4. What do you think that means for us?
- 5. What kind of responsibility has God given us to share His faithfulness with those who come after us?
- 6. What are you doing to make sure that there is not a generation who grows up without knowing the Lord?
